Excration's history of criminal 15 behavior does furnish a sound basis for the belief that he 16 is a compulsive pedophiliac, and if allowed his freedom 17 would again prev on young boys. May 11, 1977:

Talked to Don Emmer by phone. He gave me information that he was going to represent Mike Ross at his preliminary hearing on May 12, 1977, Santa Monica Superior Court. He said that currently, Mike faces five charges involving three boys whose last names are the first two boys are involved in two charges - child molestation and oral copulation. The first two boys is involved in only one charge of child molestation. The first two is the only boy I am aware of having been registered with the Boy Scouts of America. He was registered as a Scout in Troop 222, Santa Monica District in December 1976 and did not reregister in January of 1977.

I understand that the troop on occasion for several months prior to actually registering. He was known as the troop mascot.

Don Emmer informed me that Mike had been arrested five times in New York for child molestation between 1960 and 1971. He was convicted three times and acquitted once. The fifth arrest is still pending because Mike jumped bond and fled to California prior to disposition of the case.

Emmer said that the probability exists of an outstanding Federal warrant for flight to avoid prosecutionbut he is not positive of this. Ross served two jail sentences in New York and received three years' probation on the third conviction.

Emmer stated that Ross was going to plead guilty to the current charges because he felt there would probably be additional charges filed should these not be disposed of promptly.

July 12, 1977:

Don Emmer called informing me of the fact that Mike Ross, under the name of Allen Bagration, had pled guilty to three charges in return for the District Attorney dropping the remaining two charges. Sentencing will take place

on August 2, 1977. All three charges carry a 3 year-to-life sentence. This will probably turn out to be either 5 years or 15 years, depending upon whether or not the judge decides on the three sentences being concurrent or consecutive.

New York filed five charges on July 8 in Santa Monica Division, Superior Court against Allen Bagration and he will be extradited to New York following his sentencing here on August 2. His sentences will probably be served in New York following conviction. Should his ultimate sentence be less than the California sentence, he would be returned here to complete the total California sentence.

Received a call from Officer Worth of the Los Angeles Police Department requesting me to check the Confidential File on

Officer Worth informed me that Mike Ross had served two years at Rikers Island Prison in New York for child molestation. He had teaching credentials at one time but they had been revoked because of child molestation charges. Officer Worth also stated that Mike had jumped bail and fled New York prior to sentencing on one or more convictions of child molestation.

May 2, 1977 - 11:30 AH

Called Paul Ernst at National Personnel and asked him to run a check on Allan Pagration. His report was negative.

May 2,1977 - 11:40 AM

I called Officer Worth and reported these negative findings. He was very critical of the Boy Scouts of America and this council for permitting individuals like Mike Ross to become Scout leaders. He stated that he felt the Scouting organization had a responsibility to insure that the Scouts maintained the "inversion flag, apple pie, all the good impressions that the public has of Scouting". Worth stated that in view of the fact that we knew about Mike two years ago and did nothing about it left us open to criticism. I told him that I was not aware of any such notification.

He said that Mr. And had told us of a problem with Mike Ross and that a Santa Monica school principal, Mathematical had also discussed the problem with Maury Fulkerson of our staff. I confirmed that Maury had talked with Mr. And the concerning Mr. And that we had clicked with Mr. And to secure a signed complaint giving details of any charges being made. This verbal request was followed by a letter confirming the request. No such complaint has been received to date. Therefore, no action could be taken.

Officer Worth stated that the police report was going to be very critical of the Boy Scouts concerning the apparent laxness in the control over the type of leadership we have. He said he felt that we might go so far as to request a fingerprint

check on leaders before they become active.

I explained the Boy Scouts procedure of registration to Officer Worth, as well as the selection process of securing a Scoutmaster. I also explained the procedure involved in the Confidential File maintained by National. He did not seem satisfied with our methods.

I closed our conversation with a request for any pattern or mold that he could provide that would enable us to use satisfactory measure to the our leaders.

May 2, 1977 - 2:00 PM

Talked to Hr. Fulkerson about the school principal report concerning Mike Ross. He confirmed/the facts I had given Officer Worth were correct. He further stated that at no time did he have any communication concerning Mike from Mr. **Sec.**, and did not feel that Mr. **Sec.** was aware of his discussions with Principal

Mr. Fulkerson told me that Brian Campbell and a Mr. Flascher had visited Mike at the Los Angeles County jail sometime during the previous weekend. The purpose of this visit is not known.

May 3, 1977 - 3:30 PM

I called Pon Emmer regarding Wood Badge. Buring our conversation, he said that in all probability, he would not be representing Mr. Ross but that he had talked with him and was of the opinion that Mike was not going to fight any of the current child molestation charges analyst him. Emmer further told me that the pictures that the police showed me are police prints of colored slides Mike had taken five years and. Emmer also stated that Mr. Ross had given his power of attorney to a Mr. (so far as I know, it is not the school principal) who would dispose of his personal property. Don Emmer also told me that Mike's brother, who is a well known New York photographer and a singer with the Metropolitan Opera, had no plans for posting bail for Mike since he had forfeited the last bond he had posted in New York when Mike fled to avoid sentencing. Mr. Emmer said he feels that Mike would probably be defended by a public defender and that he would probably plead guilty to some of the current charges; following this, he would be extradited to New York to face the outstanding warrant for him there.

If New York sentences him to prison/jor treatment, then California probably would not sentence him here.

The following information will bring you up-to-date on the charges which have been filed by the Los Angeles & Santa Monica Police Departments against Mike Ross:

Search

April 27, 1977 - 3:00 P.M.

Los Angeles Police Department officers Don Worth and Doug Elder informed me that Mike Ross had been arrested and served with a warrant executed at his residence; that he was being held in Santa Monica on \$25,000 bail. They asked if I knew him and I confirmed that I did.

They requested boy registration records of troops Mike Ross had been affiliated with in this area. I supplied photocopies of 1975 and 1976 charters of Troops 12 and 222 in the Santa Monica District and current year charter for Troop 222.

They asked for any information I might have concerning his Scouting history prior to registering in this council. I had none, other than the fact that Mike had indicated to me in conversation that he had been active some place back east.

They showed me a series of about 15 pornographic pictures of boys aged 10 to 15 years actively engaged in homosexual acts and asked if I could identify any of the boys. I could not. Maury Fulkerson came in at this time and they asked him if he could identify any of the boys in these pictures. He stated he recognized one of the boys as having worked at the Santa Honica Reclamation Center but did not know him by name or unit.

The officers asked if Scouting could check on prior Scouting registration of any of the following names:

Allen Grossman Al Grossman Poss Allen Grossman

They felt this was the prior name of Mike Ross and stated that as such, he had a record of prior arrests and/or conviction under one of these names. One such prior case concerned the death of a seven-year-old.

The officers felt he might have been registered in the New York area under one of these names. I told them we would check with National Personnel and see if such information was available and then call them.

April 27, 1977 - Approximately 4:45 P.H.

I returned a call from Don Emmer and found he had called me to inform me of Mike's arrest. Mike had contacted him prior to the time of the arrest for legal advice concerning his problem. Don Emmer did not indicate whether or not he had agreed to represent Mike. I told Don that I had talked to the Los Angeles Police Department concerning Mike and that I knew of his arrest on a child molestation charge.

April 28, 1977 - 9:30 A.M.

I took a call for Maury Fulkerson at the Valley office from Mr. Smart of the Evening Outlook concerning Mike's arrest. I confirmed that Mike was a Scoutmaster in the Santa Monica District and had been for the past year and a half. I also informed him that Mike had been active in Scouting in this area for about two and a half years.

April 28, 1977 - 10:30 A.M.

Dave Mickelsen requested that I call Personnel at National and I did. I spoke to Paul Ernst and told him of the request from the Los Angeles Police Department about Grossman. He checked the confidential list and said they had no information on anyone named Grossman. He also stated that they would have no adult registration information except for the past two years, which we had in this council.

Paul requested that we supply information to National as it develops, including statements which are issued, charges, news articles, and - most important - final disposition of the case.

April 28, 1977 - 12:45 KM

I called Sam Jones at the Los Angeles Council office and gave him information that I had concerning Mike Ross and informed him that all requests for information would be directed to him. Sam stated he would call Bill Kephart and tell him of the pending action.

April 28, 1977 - 1:00 P.H.

I arrived at the Douglas Scout Service Center and was given notes by Doris Grabhorn of a phone conversation she had with Mike Ross during the morning. Dorie said Officers Warren and Wood of the Santa Monica Police Department had come into the office approximately 30 minutes following Mike's call and they requested a photocopy of her notes from the phone conversation. We supplied the officers with a copy of these notes.

A 40-year-old Santa Monica scoutmaster was arrested on suspicion of ichild molesting following a joint investigation by Santa Monica and Los. Angeles police, authorities reported. Michael A. Ross, employment counselor for a Venice employment agency, was booked at Santa Monica Jail. The alleged offense, involving two boys, aged 11 and 14, occurred last July, police said.



Scoutmaster Accused Of Child Molesting

A 40-year-old Santa Monica scoutmaster has been booked on suspicion of child molesting in connection with alleged sexual misconduct involving three Santa Monica boys, one of whom attended the man's scout meeting at Franklin Elementary School, police reported

Michael Allen Ross of 1519 26th Street was arrested Tuesday at a Marina del Rey employment agency, where he works as a counselor. Ile was being held today on \$25,000 bail.

Ross. who is the leader of Boy Scout Troop 222, was taken into custody following an investigation by Santa Monica and Los Angeles police.

Police said their investigation began in March after an informant gave them slides showing men engaging in lewd acts with children. The slides allegedly came from Ross's home in Venice. He later moved to Santa Monica.

Venice police reportedly have linked Ross to a child-molesting incident involving two of the boys. ages It and 14. That incident allegedly occurred in Venice last July. Ross reportedly met one of the boys through scouting. Santa Monica police said.

A Santa Monica police represenlative said investigators are interviewing several members of Troop 222. The representative added that one boy, who was not a member of the troop but who attended Monday night meetings at Franklin School, said Ross molested him during a recent meeting.

The spokesman said a complaint was to be sought from the district attorney's office against .Ross in connection with that incident.

Venice and Santa Monica police. armed with a search warrant signed by Santa Monica Municipal Judge Robert Thomas, went to Ross's home Tuesday and confiscated camera equipment and numerous undeveloped rolls of film. Police were unable to say if there were any lewd pictures in any of the material confiscated.

A spokesman for the Boy Scouts ⁷ Great Western Council said Ross ⁷ has been leader of Troop 22 for the past 1² years and has served as a volunteer with the organization for the past 2² years

After receipt of the above information, an investigation was initiated which resulted in the identification of Ralph Bonnell as being the person in possession of the aforementioned slides. On 4-5-77 Ralph Bonnell came to headquarters where he turned over to Investigators Warren and Wood a white plastic container which contained twenty-two color slides. Bonnell stated he had obtained the slides from the home of Michael Ross, who then lived on Indiana in Venice. That at that time he was leasing a garage from Ross and had permission to use the house for bathroom facilities. He had observed the slides on the coffee table in August of 1976, had been very incensed that Michael Ross would have pictures of that type and had confronted Ross with the slides, then had beat him up because he was so angry over having seen the slides.

Bonnell stated that Michael Ross had not admitted to him that he had taken the slides, however, Bonnell believed Ross made the slides because he recognized a green room divider in the slides as one belonging to Ross. Bonnell also related that Ross owns considerable photographic equipment, including cameras and photo enlargers. He also stated that Ross keeps a black metal box in his house which is kept locked with three pedlocks on each hasp and that this box is approximately three feet by two feet in size. He stated Ross is very protective of the box and would not let him, Bonnell, touch or move the box.

Investigation, revealed that Michael Ross is presently residing at 1519 26th Street, #B, Santa Monica, telephone 828-0029, and is employed as an Employment Counselor at Apple One Employment Agency, 2534 Lincoln Blvd., Marina Del Rey. It was further learned that Michael Ross is a Boy Scout Leader in charge of Troop 222 which meets on Monday nights at Franklin School in Santa Manica.

Because of Bonnell's statement that he had taken the slides from a residence in Venice, contact was made with LAPD regarding the possibility of the slides had been made in their jurisdiction. Efforts by both Santa Monica and L. A. P. D. investigators to identify the young boys shown in the slides engaging in the sexual activities proved negative.
