A grand jury is investigating incidents related to the arrest of two Colorado Springs men who have been falled on complaints of sexual assaults on children, sheriff's deputles said Tuesday

The two men are Harold Carl Voges, 25, of 110 Grinnell St. and voges, 25, of the Gruneu St. and All Matthew Lenich, 19, of 2919 Cambridge Court, said De-tectives Kathy Woosley and Deanna Olmstead.

Voges has been released from FI Paso County Jatl on a personal recognizance bond, according to just records. Bond on Lenich, who remains in custody, was set

Voges was arrested on one count of sexual assault on a child without force and one count of conspiracy to commit sexual assault without force, Ms. Woosley

Louish was arrested on two counts of sexual assault on a child without force, one count of sexual assault on a child with force and one count of con-spiracy to commit sexual assault on a child without force, jall records showed.

The arrests were made follow-ing a car accident involving one of the men. During investigation of the accident, law enforcement officials discovered several jurid snapshota of children, Ms. Woosley, said.

Further information led sheriff's officials to believe the men were connected to the sex-

ual assaults of four young boys that occurred "during various social activities in the Widefield area," Ms. Woosley said.

The grand jury investigation is being headed by Deputy Dist. Atty. Cindy Pring.

Scout leaders charged

Two former Boy Scout leaders were charged Thursday in connection with alleged sexual assaults on a member of their troop and a boy who was a habysitter for one of the leaders.

Harold Voges, 25, of 110 Grinnell St., was charged with conspiracy to commit sexual assault on a child without force, and Alan Lenich, 19, of 2919 Cambridge Court, with two counts of sexual assault on a child without force.

Voges was 'scoutmaster of Troop 173 and Lenich was his assistant. The alleged victims are 9 and 13 years old.

The incidents allegedly occurred between July 1978 and the string of 1977.

spring of 1977.

Buddy Sample, field master of the regional Boy Scout movement, said the two men were removed from their posts last summer when the allegations came to light.

The case came to the attention of authorities when Lenich had a car accident and a garage repairman found allegedly lurid photos of children inside the vehicle.

In the eight years he has been associated with scouting he said

In the eight years he has been associated with scouling he said this is only the second time such allegations have been made.

"It is not widespread, especially when you consider that we have about 2,000 Boy Scout leaders here."

Voges and Lenich were arrosted last week. They are scheduled to appear for arraignment today in Fourth Judicial District Court. Conspiracy in this case is a Class-5 felony, carrying, upon conviction, a prison term of up to live years. Sexual assault on a child without force is a Class-6 felony, carrying, upon conviction, up to 10 years.



A grand jury is investigating incidents related to the arrest of two Colorado Springs men who have been jalled on complaints of sexual abstults on children

sheriff's deputies said Tuesday. The two men are Harold Carl The two men are Harold Carl Voges, 25, of 110 Grinnell St. and Alan Matthew Lenich, 19, of 2919 Cambridge Court, said De-tectives Kathy Woosley and Denna Olmstead.

Voges has been released from El Paso County Jall on a personal recognizance bond, according to Jall records. Bond on Lenich, o remains in custody, was set at 18.500.

Voges was arrested on one count of sexual assault on a child without force and one count of conspiracy to commit sexual as sault without force, Ms. Woosley

Harold Voges, 25, of 110 Grinnell St., was charged with conspiracy to commit sexual assault on a child without force, and Alan Lenich, 19, of 2019 Cambridge Court, with two counts of sexual sexual on a child without force. assault on a child without force.

Voges was scoutmaster of Troop 173 and Lenich was his assistant. The alleged victims are 9 and 13 years old.

The incidents allegedly occurred between July 1978 and the

The incidents allegedly occurred between July 1978 and the spring of 1977.

Buddy Sample, field master of the regional Boy Scout movement, said the two men were removed from their posts last summer when the allegations came to light.

The case came to the attention of authorities when Lenich had a car accident and a garage repairman found allegedly lurid photos of children inside the vehicle.

In the eight years he has been associated with scouting he said

In the eight years he has been associated with scouling he said this is only the second time such allegations have been made.
"It is not widespread, especially when you consider that we have about 2,000 Bry Scout leaders here."

Voges and Lenich were arrested last week. They are scheduled to appear for arraignment today in Fourth Judicial District Court.

Conspiracy in this case is a Class-5 felony, carrying, upon conviction, a prison term of up to five years. Sexual assault on a child without force is a Class-5 felony carrying upon conviction, up in 10.
