In regard to the inquiry on Al Conekin, Cliff Eng directed me to meet with Mr. Conekin.

On Saturday, June 28, 1986, 10:00 a.m., Richard Musgraves, Executive Board Member, Robert Shiells, District Executive, and myself, David Anderson, Scout Executive, met with Al Conekin at Camp Pine Ridge. I read the following statement to Mr. Conekin:

"I have been directed by the Boy Scouts of America, North Central Region, to ask you, Al Conekin, for your written permission to inquire with the State of Illinois Department of Children and Family Services regarding any incident pertaining to child abuse involving yourself. I must have your permission by July 2, 1986, 12:00 noon. Failure to provide said permission in writing will mean your immediate dropping from the membership rolls of the Boy Scouts of America."


To Whom It May Concern:
