Dear Ray,

Shortly after your arrival at the Capitol Area Council, Troop 421 presented several suspicions we had concerned an individual who had registered as an Assistant Scoutmaster with our unit. As you might recall, Scouting Coordinator Frank Ivy, Committee Chairman Matt Pogor and I, as Scoutmaster, met with you to discuss the topic.

There was concern that the individual, Alexander Dalton Argyris, was attempting to develop a physical relationship with one or more of the Scouts. One family in particular was involved and had tried, without success, to keep Argyris from contact with their son.

Argyris was not reregistered with the unit at the next charter renewal. He did, however, continue trying to contact the young man for more than a year.


Argyris made many harassing telephone calls to the residence after the mother told him no longer to contact her son. Through the Austin Police Department and Southwestern Bell Telephone, a trap was installed on the line and enough evidence was gathered to file charges.

The young man, now in college, confided in me in December that when he was 14 years old, Argyris took him to his office one evening and asked if he could perform oral sex on the boy. The boy does not wish to carry this any further and asked that I deal with the incident in confidence.

With this pattern of behavior I suggest that Argyris be noted as one who should not be involved with Scouting units in any capacity.
