SUBJECT: Alfred Francis Cote

On July 14 at approximately 10:30 A.M., I received a call from Mr. Alfred Francis Cote. Mr. Cote called after having talked to the Scout Executive and the President of Council No. 171. They indicated to Mr. Cote that we would not accept his registration with the Boy Scouts of America, since he was on the Confidential File.

Mr. Cote was referred to us since they did not have the file. Mr. Cote had been placed on the file in 1984 when he live in New Hampshire. Mr. Cote asked us to substantiate why he was on the file and afterwards he asked if we had newspaper clippings. I indicated we did from New Hampshire which indicated that he had been charged with sexual molestation.

Mr. Cote plans to appeal since he says these charges were dismissed and that he was eventually acquitted of these charges. He did indicate that he was found guilty of some misdemeanors, but did not explain what they were.

I suggested to Mr. Cote that he could write a letter to the council and give adequate proof that the charges which we originally presented were incorrect and that he was acquitted of all these charges. The committee could then decide whether or not he should be reinstated after evaluating all the facts.

This memorandum for the file is in case further action becomes necessary.

Mr. Alfred F. Cote called me on 7-10-89 wanting to meet regarding his adult application. I shared with Mr. Cote that I wouldn't sign his application or approve his registration upon recommendations of the National Office.

I suggested that he could appeal by sending a letter to our Council president. Mr. Cote insisted on meeting. We met at 2:00 p.m. on 7/10/89 at the Council Service Center. Prior to meeting with Mr. Cote I made the following calls:

Paul Ernst -- National Office Shirley Linn -- Regional Office Jim Nagel -- Past Scout Executive Doug Worden -- Council President.

Paul Ernst shared with me that Mr. Cote had several past convictions for sexual assault and that we should not approve his application. Paul suggested that I have a local volunteer present when I met with Mr. Cote. Russ Myatt, our Council Vice President for Membership was in the office so I reviewed the situation with Russ. Russ suggested that I should not approve the application nor should the council. Russ couldn't meet at 2:00 p.m. so I called Doug Worden, our Council President.

Doug came to the office at 1:55 p.m. Doug and I reviewed the application and situation. Doug agreed that Mr. Cote should not be a leader. Prior to meeting with Doug, I tried to contact our Council leagal advisor, Mr. Terry Loeschen. Terry was unavailable.

Because of my not knowing Mr. Cote and because of his past record, I asked the Chief of Police, Mr. Wendell Patton, to send an officer over. Patrolman Tim Orth sat outside the office in a waiting area. Officer Orth was not a part of the conversation with Mr. Cote, nor did Mr. Cote know why the officer was there.


Prior to meeting with Mr. Cote and Doug Worden, I called Shirley Linn with the Regional Office. Shirley said no one was available. I shared with Shirley the procedure I was going to follow so she could document that I had informed the Regional Office.

Prior to meeting with Mr. Cote and D oug Worden, I reviewed the pamphlet "Child Sexual Abuse and How to Deal With It".

I introduced myself and Doug Worden to Mr. Cote. I then shared with Mr. Cote the fact that we would not approve his application because of recommendations given to us from our National Office. Mr. Cote stated that he wanted to get to the bottom of this matter. Mr. Cote stated that Jim Nagel told him that he should fill out an application so it could be processed, so he could find out if they would approve his application if he went through the local appeal process.

Mr. Cote was give a letter addressed to him by Doug Worden -- the letter is on file -- and was followed as outlined on page 16 Appendix C -- Mr. Cote was also provided with a copy of Appendix D - pay 17 - which outlines the appeal process.

Mr. Cote did inform Doug Worden and myself that he was convicted of three (3) misdemeanors but they were all vacated in 1987. Doug Worden gave Mr. Cote the letter stating that Mr. Cote's registration is denied by the council. Accompanying the letter was a copy of the appeal process. Mr. Cote was cordial and stated that he would follow the process. Mr. Cote then asked for phone numbers of people with National.



Mr. Cote then left.

After Mr. Cote left, I shared the incident with Officer Tim Orth and he took notes and then left. No files charged and no one accused. I simply let the officer know the situation.

Afterwards I talked with our Council legal representative Terry Loeschen. I shared with Terry the situation. Terry suggested I send a copy of the letter to him and the National Office, but no one else. This, I did.

Dear Jim:

I understand that Fred Cote has made statements to the effect that I was aware of certain legal difficulties in which he might have been involved. I need to advise you that I was not aware, prior to your inquiry, of any specific legal difficulties that he might have.

My first contact with this gentleman was at the LDS Church in Nauvoo. I met him sometime during mid winter. The introduction was unremarkable. I recall nothing about the introduction other than he was new in the area.

We began recruiting for a trek to Philmont in August, 1987. At that time we were recruiting young men and leaders from both the Nauvoo and the Columbia Stakes. My wife received a call one evening in late winter from Mr. Cote where he expounded a wealth of Scouting background and abilities, professing even to have been on the committee which wrote the Church Scouting Handbook. He said that although he had had this marvelous background, he had never had the time to go to Woodbadge. He also had an interest in attending NC529, as well as an interest in serving as a leader on our Philmont Trek. He attended the Philmont Trek Training which was held at Kirksville, Missouri in March. No conversations of any particular nature were held at that time.

In keeping with BSA policy, we established all of our crews with two adults per crew. Mr. Cote was an assistant advisor in a crew in which the advisor was Larry Allen. The crew was made up primarily of boys from Southeast Iowa Council (Nauvoo and Donaldson). I do recall Larry Allen making the statement to me when I saw him on the trail (at Indian Writings) that Fred undermined his authority continually. Every time Larry would tell the boys that they would have to do something, Fred would try to change the directions that Larry had given. I am not aware of any incidents on the Trek, other than apparently a constant bickering caused by Fred.

I did have an inquiry from Mr. Cote in April or May concerning legal procedure. He stated to me that he had some kind of Federal Court case pending in Chicago in which he was a Plaintiff. He did not relate to me the details of the case. He was asking about interrogatories. He indicated that he was going to send several hundred interrogatories to each Defendant. (Interrogatories are questions which Defendants must answer under oath.) I

told him that he would need to verify what the local rule was because in many Federal Courts you are not permitted to submit more than 20 interrogatories without Court approval. This was the end of the conversation and I was never told by him the nature of that lawsuit.

I have found out during and subsequent to NC529 that Mr. Cote is in very serious legal difficulties in several states. I was not made aware of this information prior to my conversation with you just prior to the course beginning.

I was never advised by anyone at the Nauvoo Ward that Fred Cote was not registered in Scouting. When the Philmont registrations were submitted to us, we presumed, since they were handled through the local units, that the local units had insured that the leaders were in fact registered with the Boy Scouts of America.

I have had conversations with Bishop Durrell Nelson of the Nauvoo Ward. I understand from Bishop Nelson that Mr. Cote is quite a talker and has "taken in" a number of people. I also understand that Mr. Cote may have on occasion made statements suited to his purposes. One such statement of which I am aware is the statement that I was aware of his legal situation. Mr. Cote never related to me his legal status. The first knowledge I had of pending charges was from the information I received during the NC529 conversations with yourself and with John Watters.

With respect to the trip to New York, the Bishop related the following to me:

The Scoutmaster for Troop 107 requested authorization for the Scout Troop to accompany Mr. Cote on a trip to Western New York to the Hill Cumorah Pagent. The Bishop told the Scoutmaster that he would not authorize such a scout trip. Further, the Bishop said that he told him that he could not control what the parents of certain boys might allow them to do. The Bishop told him that if he had the boys parents' permission for them to travel along, not as a scout activity, that he could not stop them from doing so. It is my understanding that no tour permit was requested by Troop 107 for that trip. I have heard, although I have not confirmed, that it is possible that at least Mr. Cote, and perhaps others, were wearing scout uniforms in the area of the Hill Cumorah Pagent. If this happened I am not sure of the reason why it was done, in view of the fact this was specifically not a scout activity.

I trust this information is informative and helpful to you. If I may answer further questions, please contact me.

In 1984, we placed an individual on the Confidential File from the council in New Hampshire. The cause was sexual child abuse.

In 1937, this individual tried to register in Indiana. We stopped his registration and later received a newspaper clipping, which indicated he again had been arrested for sexual child abuse.

In 1998, an individual from the council in New Hampshire recognized this individual in either New York or Washington, D.C. This individual notified their council that this man was wearing a Scout uniform with insignia indicating Troop 107. They thought he was from Illinois.

We searched all of our file for Troop 107 and eventually found several Troop 107's. We then narrowed this to councils in Illinois or surrounding states. Eventually, we called a council and found that this individual was participating in the council and in fact was going to attend a Wood Badge course starting on August 13. Because of our call, he was stopped from attending this.

He also had been to Philmont within the last month, with a group and apparently had been on this trip east with a group of Scouts and Scouters associated with the Hormon church.

I wanted to bring to your attention that we do have people participating who are not registered. We wondered what type of incentive we could give to councils to make certain that every individual who participates in anyway, attends any course, or is involved, has a valid registration.

Thanks for your concern and any help you can give me.

Scout leader faces sex assault charges

A 27-year-old Chicago Heights Boy Scout leader, convicted of molesting three New Hampshire boys, was held in Will County Jail yesterday on charges that he sexually assaulted two of his girlfriend's sons.

Alfred Francis Cote, of Monee, was arrested Tuesday and charged with two counts of aggravated criminal sexual assault for attacks on two boys, ages 9 and 12, who had lived with him for four months,

according to Will County Sheriff's Lt. Shirley Eichholzer.

The boys were sons of Cote's girlfriend. They, another brother and a sister had been living with Cote until late November.

Cote moved to Monee after being convicted last year of molesting three boys in his Boy Scout troop in Rockingham County, N.H. He was out on bond pending an appeal of that conviction.





Alfred Cote, 26, of 39 Long Pond Road, is free on \$6,000 personal recognizance bail following his arrest Dec. 19 by the Rockingham County Sheriff's Department in cooperation with the Danville and Londonderry Police Departments.

According to Dr. Wayne Gersen, superintendent of schools, Cote has been teaching an electricity course at the vocational school since September.

He has been "removed from the assignment with pay in accordance with state statutes." according to Gersen.

Cote was removed from assignment following his arrest Dec. 1 by the Londonderry Police, said Gersen, who added the school is also looking into the situation. "We'd like to move on this quickly and quietly and we've been taking steps to do that."

He declined to comment further. "On advice of our attorney, the best answer I can give you in this case is no answer. I'm just not at liberty to say anything about this.

Londonderry Police arrested Cote at 11 p.m. Dec. 1 on three counts of sexual assault involving two Londonderry boys. ages nine and 11. The alleged assaults happened at a private residence, police said.

Cote is scheduled to appear in Derry District Court Feb. 7 on those charges.

The assaults for which Cote was arrested in Danville, allegedly occurred at a Danville business and involve at least

After careful review, we have decided that your registration with the Boy Scouts of America should be suspended. We are therefore compelled to request that you sever any relations that you may have with the Boy Scouts of America.

We reserve the right to suspend registration whenever there is a concern that an individual may not measure up to the high standards of leadership which the BSA seeks to provide for American youth.
