

This subject was arrested by members of this division on January 7, 1961. He was charged with two counts of Unnatural Acts and three counts of Contributing to the Delinquency of a Minor.

On January 9, 1961, he was convicted in Worcester Central District Court of the above crimes, and was given six months concurrent sentence on each complaint, suspended to one year probation with the provision that he be treated by Dr. Mason, the court psychiatrist. Judge Riley presided.

It is my opinion that Alfred Morin should have no connection whatsoever with the Scouting movement.
