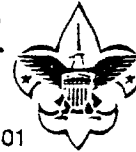

Allen Jurek was dismissed from the Oviedo Police Department as a result of rumors that he was having "relationships" with members of Post 851 chartered to the Oviedo Police Department. The department chose not to take action against Mr. Jurek other than to inform us that they had dismissed him from the Exploring program and the department. We in turn followed with the membership denial letter.

The chief of the Oviedo Police Department, other than he has promised us his birthdate and social security number does not believe that discussing what he believes to be an internal matter would benefit his department or the Boy Scouts of America.

The Post Advisor, Wayne Bensen, has advised us that Mr. Jurek still lives in Central Florida and is currently working for Publix Supermarkets. Based off of his recommendation, he feels it not wise that we allow Mr. Jurek an opportunity for to re-enter this program even though he too is not at liberty to discuss the problems that they had with the police department and Mr. Jurek. Since no criminal charges were brought up against this gentleman, I feel this is as far as we can go. The department seems to have put us at a dead end. I hope this will help to resolve this issue to at least your satisfaction.

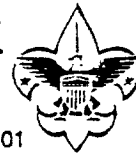

Dear Mr. Jurek:

After careful review, we have decided that your registration with the Boy Scouts of America should be denied. We are therefore compelled to request that you sever any relations that you may have with the Boy Scouts of America. A refund of your registration fee will be forwarded to you.

You should understand that BSA membership registration is a privilege and is not automatically granted to everyone who applies. We reserve the right to refuse registration whenever there is a concern that an individual may not meet the high standards of membership which the BSA seeks to provide for American youth.

If you wish to have this decision reviewed by a BSA regional review committee, please write to the regional director within 60 days of the date of this letter, explaining your version of the facts supporting your claim that your registration as a BSA member should be reinstated. The procedures for a review of this decision are attached.
