Thank you for the material you recently sent concerning Mr. Morgan. This is most helpful as we start to build a file which will allow us to refuse registration in the future. It is too bad we do not have some very definite things we can pin on him, but it sounds like he should not be registered. According to what you have said, I do not believe there is any solid information that he really is a child abuser. I still feel he should be placed on the file and refused registration.

The only thing I still need is an Ineligible Volunteer Record Sheet. I am enclosing one and would like for you to complete this to the best of your ability, so we can identify this individual. Please do not hesitate to contact me if there is anything else we need to discuss. As soon as we receive this sheet, we will have a complete file.

Dear Paul:

Enclosed you will please find copies of the BSA Adult application, Camp Staff application and the notes on the reference checks for Andrew "Father Paul" Morgan as conducted by Kevin Bishop.

On July 11 while District Executive Phil Rockhill and I were making arrangements to use Nick's Lake in Old Forge, New York we were approached by Andrew Morgan. He indicated that he was involved as a part time chaplain at Camp Russell (General Herkimer Council) and was a minister on assignment in the Adirondacks looking for property to be purchased by a congregation in Florida. He pointed out that he was a ranger at a camp owned by the Central Florida Council. Since we were in need of a staff member I suggested that he may want to call Kevin Bishop and perhaps some arrangements would be made to house and feed him.

Applications were signed and the normal check of references begun. There were statements made by him which acted as an alarm to the adult staff members. To the best of our knowledge no contact had been made with youngsters while in our employ.

Bishop became concerned when he made contact with John Ferguson who referred to the Youth Protection Program, but would not indicate anything beyond that.

Kirkendall indicated that Morgan was a child abuser.

When I spoke to Ronnie Carroll he indicated that Morgan had been employed as a care taker at Camp Hedrick for a short period of time on a part time basis. Carroll had been told that Morgan was a child abuser on flight from the State of New York. Carroll stated that the Director of Security for Disneyland, a member of his Executive Board, had reported Morgan to be a child abuser. When Morgan was confronted with these charges he was gone in 2 weeks.

We dismissed Morgan from his position with us on July 27.

I spoke to Carl Sayer, Director at Camp Russell and reported our findings to him. He was scheduled to return on July 23. Needless to say, they would not allow his return. Steve Silverman, Scout Executive at General Herkimer Council, was on vacation. I have followed up with him and he is aware of the situation.


I spoke to the New York State Police, Oneida County Child Abuse Task Force, and New York State Child Abuse Registry on July 23 who could not or would not reveal information on Morgan because of his civil rights.

The Oneida County Child Abuse Task Force did reveal that there was no warrant for Morgan's arrest on child abuse in the the State of New York.

Personal information can be found on Morgan's application. You may wish to know that in his previous employment he has passed himself off as a priest in the Episcopal Faith, Russian Orthodox Faith, and the Church of Latter Day Saints.
