The information you have provided will enable us to identify this individual should he ever again attempt to register in the Scouting program. Much thanks for your help.

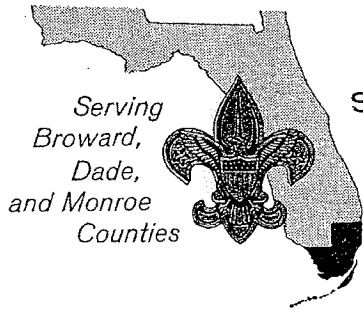

HISTORY - ANTHONY S. CHANDLER

"Tony" Chandler was assistant Scoutmaster in Troop 21 of Coconut Grove, St. Steven's Episcopal Church, year 1967. Then he came into the Scouting Center to say that he had enough boys to start a troop of his own. These boys were supposed to be of a less chance area.

He then became Scoutmaster of Troop 299 sponsored by Honda of Miami (motorcycles). The dads were on the committee. The troop continued for a few months, when the committee lost interest and the troop was disbanded - probably due to lack of cooperation from the committee. However, Chandler asked the Silver Bluff P.T.A. if they would sponsor the "unit" which they agreed since they already sponsored a pack (Pack 419). The troop was in operation about six months, and apparently very active and working very well, with an outing almost every weekend. Many of the parents were supporting him and the unit very well. Most of the parents, however, were mothers who were either divorced, separated or widowed. One weekend, Jim Watson, field director with the South Florida Council, received a call from Mr. [REDACTED], the assistant Scoutmaster, relating some of the immoral actions regarding Tony Chandler.

The following day the chairman of the committee also came to the Scouting Center and registered a complaint. It seems that the boys were being molested by Chandler, some of the boys had told their parents, but none of the parents had registered any formal complains. At this time this office sent Chandler a letter stating that his services were no longer needed.

We (the district commissioner, the assistant district commissioner and the neighborhood commissioner and the district executive) called a meeting of the parents. At the meeting Sgt. Heider was present (City of Miami Police Department). Of the parents present, several agreed to register a formal complaint. This was done individually to Sgt. Heider within the following few days. There was no question in any one's mind of those who were present at the parent's meeting that Tony Chandler was guilty of child molestation.

Anthony S. Chandler is about 5 ft. 6 in. tall, black hair, blue eyes, fair complexion, and weighs about 140 lbs. He worked for Randall Eastern Ambulance as an ambulance driver; also worked as a male nurse. He is single, age 22 years. Religious preference - Episcopalian.

The case was turned over to Sam Alter, State Attorney's Office, and they issued two warrants for his arrest.

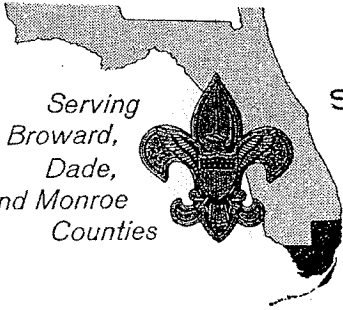
