
Dear Arnold:

After careful review, we have decided that your registration with the Boy Scouts of America should be denied. We are therefore compelled to request that you sever any relations that you may have with the Boy Scouts of America. A refund of your registration fee is enclosed.

You should understand that BSA membership registration is a privilege and is not automatically granted to everyone who applies. We reserve the right to refuse registration whenever there is a concern that an individual may not meet the high standards of membership which the BSA seeks to provide for American youth.

If you wish to have this decision reviewed by a BSA regional review committee, please write to the regional director within 60 days of the date of this letter, explaining your version of the facts supporting your claim that registration as a BSA member should be reinstated. The procedures for a review of this decision are attached.

The following information is provided should you desire review by the North Central Region, BSA, of the decision to deny your registration.

1. Within 60 days, you must request in writing a review of this decision. Your request should be sent to the regional director, North Central Region, BSA. In your request you may include your version of what occurred in support of your claim that your registration should not have been denied.
2. Upon the receipt of your written request, a committee will be appointed to review the situation.
3. You may attend the review hearing, but it is not adversarial in nature and neither the committee nor you will be represented by legal counsel. If you wish, you may be accompanied by no more than two other individuals if their testimony might assist the committee in discovering the truth and arriving at a correct decision.
4. The committee will review the facts as presented, and may interview any persons whose testimony might assist them in arriving at a correct decision.
5. You will receive a letter setting forth the decision of the committee.
6. If you disagree with the decision of the committee, you may request a review of this decision by the National Council of the Boy Scouts of America.

MEMORANDUM OF CONVERSATION

December 1, 1990

At 12:45 P.M., on this date, I hand carried and presented a letter denying registration, procedures for review, and a check refunding registration, to Mr. Arnold A. Volkmar at the First Presbyterian Church in Greenville, Illinois, with Executive Board Member Ron Luebben as witness.

After reading the letter, Mr. Volkmar told Ron and I that "this must have come from his divorce eight years ago when his ex-mother-in-law got his daughters to testify to a counselor that he had sexually molested them". Neither Ron nor I either confirmed or denied Mr. Volkmar's suspicion.

Mr. Volkmar then called [REDACTED] out into the hall, showed them the letter, repeated his suspicion, and said that "he didn't fight it (the sexual molestation charge) because he didn't have the money or want to mess them [REDACTED] up any more".

The [REDACTED] encouraged Mr. Volkmar to pursue the review process. At this point Mr. Volkmar picked up his things and left the building. The [REDACTED] Mr. Lubben and I discussed what to do with Mr. Volkmar's den. [REDACTED] mentioned that Mr. Volkmar had not been allowed to see [REDACTED] at all since his divorce.

Mr. Volkmar came back into the church and asked about the review process, specifically how he could include his version of what occurred (step #1) if he didn't know what he had done. I told him that he could either include the above stated suspicion or simply state that he didn't know. At this point Mr. Volkmar again left the building and conversation was concluded.
