This letter is in regards to the removal of Art Zenzen as our Assistant Cub Master.

I have known Art for a number of years, and quite frankly, I haven't met many people with the courage, determination, and honesty that Art possesses.

Art and I are good friends, and I would trust my own child with him more than most other adults.

What impressed me most about Art was his openness and self admission to his problem of sex abuse. I sensed very deep remorse for his actions. He served his time, underwent counseling, and returned home several months later to rebuild his life. Art has become very active in A.A. and his Church, and despite his ordeal, has regained dignity in our community, and most of all, has regained dignity, honor, and love of his family.

Art had become a very good scout leader. Along with his wife, Mary, they probably had one of the best dens in our pack. The boys truly adore Art, and they look up to him for leadership. Art was also my Assistant Cubmaster. We were working together very well, and I do miss him.

I believe, Art feels this is his second chance in life, and he is going to make the most of it, which he certainly is. He is once again a fine husband, and father.

I feel we all make a mistake or two in our life but what is most important is what we learn from those mistakes, no matter how serious. His dues have been paid.

Art, in my estimation, has made full amends to his family, and the state, and is trying to put all this behind him.

Art is a perfect example of a person who faced a grim future, but with help from his counselors, family, friends, and God, he has turned his life around to become a fine human being. After all, isn't this part of what we try to teach the boys? That every body makes mistakes, everybody makes a wrong choice or decision, but if we are given another chance and have learned from it, aren't we better people because of

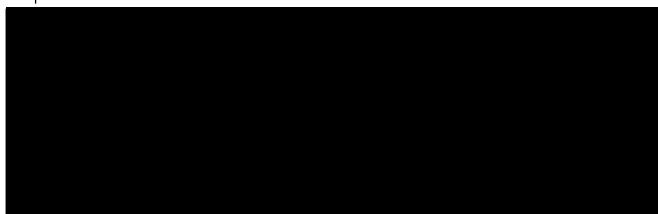
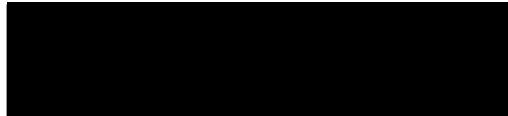

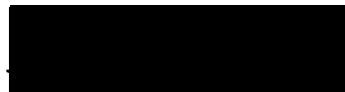

In April of 1990, Our son's Den Leader decided to quite so he left 6 boys hanging. My Wife + I talked it over and decided to finish out the year with the boys and we did.

We were very proud of our boys, they came a long way while we had them for that short time and the boys liked us too.

When I filled out my application I was very honest with all of the questions as you can see. I could have lied about the whole thing but I didn't. I am sure some people do but I don't have anything to hide. I served my time and took it. I know I had done wrong.

Since the time of my sexual assault I have been sober and have been very active in the A.A. program and as of Aug 17, 1991 I have been sober for 5 yrs. which I am also very proud of.

Last year when scouting began I was very excited about it because the boys were a year older and knew a lot more.

We had 10 boys in our Den and we had 4 leaders with my wife as den leader. This year we have 4 Boys with still 4 leaders now 3.

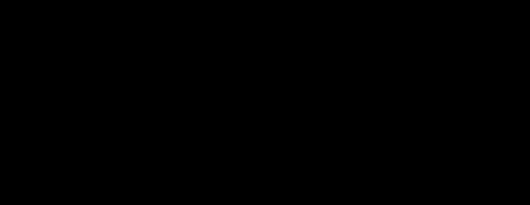
