Please have this letter serve to advise that we have removed Arthur Alexander from the membership of the Boy Scouts of America due to his plead of guilty to child abuse, third degree. Sentencing is scheduled for December 22nd. Attached "docket of information" is from the Montgomery County Criminal Court of Maryland.

Arthur, who is approximately fifty-years of age, lives in Blinklow, Maryland, is divorced and perhaps remarried. He is civilian employed by the government and is part time employee of a horse stable in Montgomery County. He was indicted and arrested for 12-15 counts of sexual abuse of a female, fourteen years of age or younger, and will face perhaps up to ten years imprisoned if he is not placed on probation.


