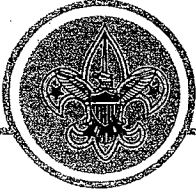



At the suggestion of our Assistant Commissioner, Ron Eaton, I am writing this letter to you directly as a form of a formal complaint against our now currently registered Scoutmaster, Barney Perdue, to substantiate my verbal complaint made to Mr. Eaton during the past few days.

The numerous indignities that many of the boys in this Scout Troop have been subjected to, by Barney Perdue by his homosexual tendency, during the past many months has just recently been brought to the attention of some of us parents of Scouts. My son was one of these boys.

I wish to state that I am - and will continue to be - fully behind Mr. Eaton in his decisions and the handling of matters in our Scouting Program. I feel that this most unfortunate incident here in our City has been partly resolved by Mr. Perdue's leaving our City. However, I am greatly concerned that other boys, perhaps Scouts again, could be subjected to such indignities in another city where Mr. Perdue may once again offer his "help" in the Scouting Program. Thus I heartily endorse any action that you may see fit to pursue to curtail this man's activities with Scouts or any boys, for that matter.

Thank you for your cooperation in this matter and please feel free to call upon me, should you have any need to do so.

With reference to our discussion earlier this month regarding the homosexual tendency of our currently registered Scoutmaster, Barney Perdue.



The parent who first brought this matter to my attention does not wish to sign his name to a formal complaint; however, with the personal admission of these problems by Mr. Perdue, and individual discussions with some of the boys involved, I feel it imperative that the aforementioned action be taken.

I have been approached by another parent, since our discussion, who wished to meet with other parents to discuss the problem further. I imagine that you will be receiving more letters concerning this matter in the near future.
