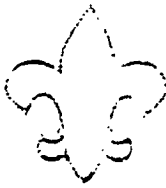

Dear Mr. Wearing:

After careful review, we have decided that your registration with the Boy Scouts of America should not be accepted. We are therefore compelled to request that you sever any relations that you may have with the Boy Scouts of America.

You should understand that BSA leadership registration is a privilege and is not automatically granted to everyone who applies. We reserve the right to refuse registration whenever there is a concern that an individual may not measure up to the high standards of leadership which the BSA seeks to provide for American youth. Please also understand that this decision and the reasons for it will be maintained as confidential.

If you wish to have this decision reviewed, please write to me, explaining your version of the facts supporting your claim that your registration as a BSA leader should be granted or reinstated.

RE: Report of Alleged Incident

Tonight, at approximately 8:15pm, I received a call from ADC Jim Voelker stating that he had found out why Ben Wearing had resigned from all Scouting activities last week (he resigned from P30, T30 and Pioneer Trails District via letter). According to the story that Jim heard, Ben had been "touching young boys' bodies where he shouldn't have"; Ben had allegedly done it before, but it never could be proved - this time he was caught. Ben was supposedly given the choice of resigning or "facing the consequences"; the church and the pack do not want "is to get out". (there are rumors "all over" Christ the King Catholic Church) He is not accused of being involved with homosexual acts, just sexual/physical abuse, according to one account relayed by ADC Voelker. One of the boys involved will not go to meetings any more; a second boy "will not leave his house".

I attempted to call Marcus Mack(DD) and Dan Wheatcroft(SE), and finally was able to make contact with Harvey R. Thompson(DFS) near 8:30pm, this date.
