Dear Mr. Hoover:


I feel I must protest the very unfair and high-handed treatment our St. Pius X Boy Scout Troop has received in regard to their Scoutmaster. I'm referring, of course, to the notice that Bernie Heindel -- for unspecified reasons -- has been declared unacceptable by your committee to continue to serve as Scoutmaster.

Had you been present at our discussion the other evening, you'd realize the terribly unpleasant suspicions your secretive handling of this matter has aroused. When we are told nothing, we can only surmise the worst! What else could possibly prompt you to take such drastic action?

Has Bernie absconded with funds?...been caught with pot in his pipe?...been running a school for thieves? Has he been advocating Communism?...promoting revolution?...buggin^g your headquarters? Or, horror of horrors, is it sex?

Whatever it is -- all of the above or none of the above -- I feel it is unfair to St. Pius and immensely unfair to Bernie to dismiss him without a hearing -- and to keep us, the parents most directly involved, in the dark as to your reasons. Complete disclosure of the entire matter to our committee would seem to be the only proper course.

Do we deserve any less?

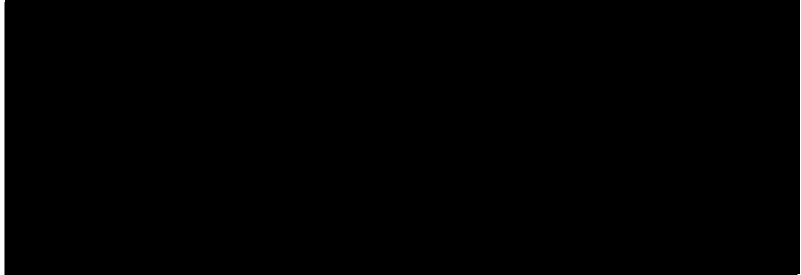
