Dear Mr. Farar:

After careful review, we have decided that your registration with the Boy Scouts of America should be denied. We are therefore compelled to request that you sever any relations that you may have with the Boy Scouts of America. A refund of your registration fee is enclosed.

You should understand that BSA membership registration is a privilege and is not automatically granted to everyone who applies. We reserve the right to refuse registration whenever there is a concern that an individual may not meet the high standards of membership which the BSA seeks to provide for American youth.

If you wish to have this decision reviewed by a BSA regional review committee, please write to the regional director within 60 days of the date of this letter, explaining your version of the facts supporting your claim that your registration as a BSA member should be reinstated. The procedures for a review of this decision are attached.

Attachment to Letter

The following information is provided should you desire a review by the Southeast Region, B.S.A., of the decision to deny your registration.

1. Within 60 days, you must request in writing a review of this decision. Your request should be sent to the Regional Director, Southeast Region, B.S.A., PO Box 440728, Kennesaw, Georgia 30144. In your request you may include your version of what occurred in support of your claim that your registration should not have been denied.
2. Upon the receipt of your written request, a committee will be appointed to review the situation.
3. You may attend the review hearing, but it is not adversarial in nature and neither the committee nor you will be represented by legal counsel. If you wish, you may be accompanied by no more than two other individuals if their testimony might assist the committee in discovering the truth and arriving at a correct decision.
4. The committee will review the facts as presented, and may interview any persons whose testimony might assist them in arriving at a correct decision.
5. You will receive a letter setting forth the decision of the committee.
6. If you disagree with the decision of the committee, you may request a review of this decision by the National Council of the Boy Scouts of America.

April 25, 1990 1:00 a.m.

SUBJECT: Boyd Farar

At 11:00 a.m. a conference was held in the conference room of the administration building at Sunland Center with following persons present: Boyd Farar, Duan Copeland, (Sunland Inspection General) Bob Mitchell, (Council Camping chairman - Captain Gainesville Police Department) and Steven Moore (BSA).

I made the statement that generally we knew why we were present and there wasn't any need to go back and rehash the issue that brought us here. I asked Boyd Farar if he was aware of our Youth Protection Program of the Boy Scouts of America, and he said he was not. I indicated that about 2½ years ago the Boy Scouts became very serious about certain incidences of abuse and illusions thereof. I advised him that on occasions where there were some questions about a persons propriety to be involved with Scouting that it left us no option but to remove the person from Boy Scout participation until the issues were resolved.

I read Boyd Farar his letter, I advised him of the appeal process, presented him a check and asked him if he had any questions. He asked Duane Copeland how to put the refund check into an account at Sunland. Copeland indicated that the deposit could be arranged. He had no other questions about the circumstances and raised no objections. We shook hands and the meeting was adjourned.

4/18/90 9:00 a.m.

Vic Carpenter and I met with Rosa Williams at Sunland Administration Building. After advising Mrs. Williams that we had a concern about Boyd Farar and his relationship with other people she invited Duane Copeland, "Inspector General" at Sun to meet with us. Duane Copeland's phone number is [REDACTED]. We reviewed with Rosa Williams and Duane Copeland the concerns expressed by [REDACTED] of Boyd Farar. Copeland indicated that he would like to have a statement from [REDACTED] and we agreed to coordinate visits having HRS representative and Boy Scouts of America visit Farar at the same time.

We agreed to get in touch with [REDACTED] and see if an arrangement could be made and he would be willing to talk with Duane Copeland. Copeland agreed to go visit with [REDACTED] wherever he would be available.

Phone was made to [REDACTED] and arrangements were agreed upon to call him again at 1:30 on 4/18/90 to see if he could visit with Steve Moore for a few minutes at that time.

4/19/90 9:15 p.m.

I raised a conference call between [REDACTED] and William Copeland regarding Mr. Copeland's interest in talking with [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] agreed to go visit with Mr. Copeland at Sunland at 2:00 in the afternoon April ¹⁹ 20 and share with him his concerns of Boyd Farar.

I reminded Mr. Copeland that I wanted to personally visit with Boyd Farar at a point in time he and I may need to coordinate that particular event and we agreed to touch base by telephone Monday of next week to arrange for such a meeting.

[REDACTED] had completed 10 hours of service and had missed some scheduled time. On Friday morning, April 13, 1990, he contacted Boyd Farar to arrange for the extra time assignment. Farar didn't want to talk about the issue at that time and that he would call back. About 4:30 on the same day, Farar called [REDACTED]. Farar requested to preform oral sex on [REDACTED] in exchange for his 10 hours of service and offered to give him good marks.

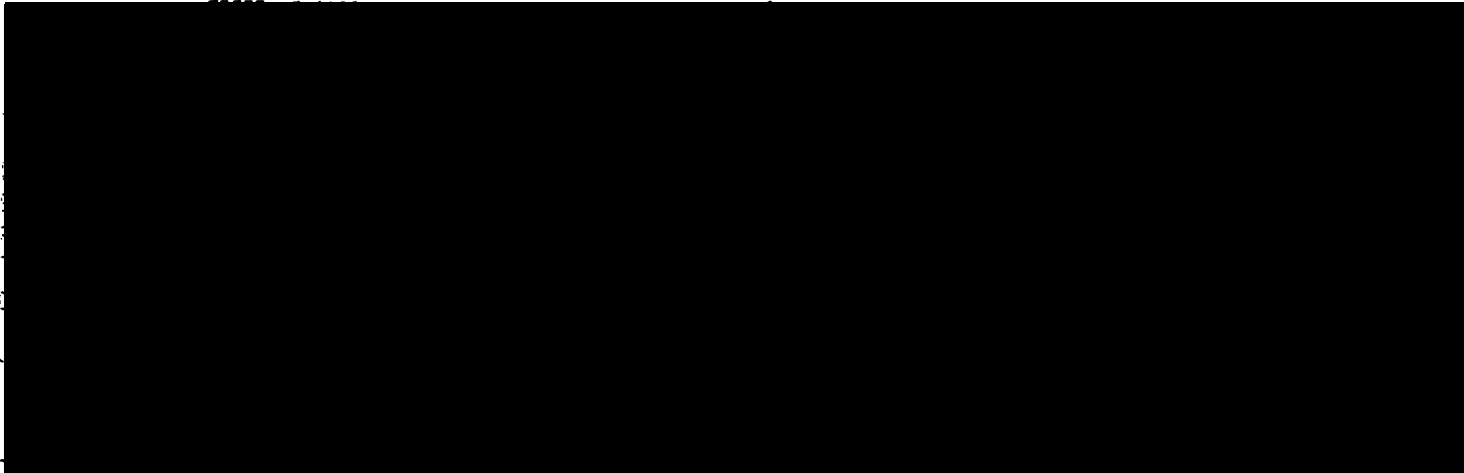
[REDACTED] contacted District Executive Vic Carpenter. Carpenter talked with Steve Moore, Sunday afternoon the 15th of April.
