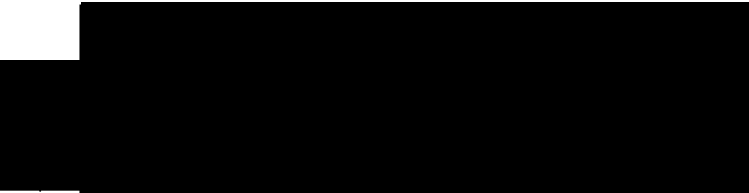

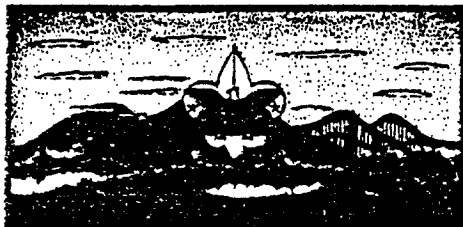

However, my suggestion is that Mr. Maxson be placed in your caution file as a precaution. Should [REDACTED] ever send a statement, or if someone else comes forward, I will, of course, alert your office immediately.

While we're at it, as a final report on Kevin Kriner, he pleaded guilty to one count of child sexual abuse and is now serving time for the conviction. I have requested that the Court Clerk send you, directly, a copy of the conviction record for your files.

With this letter I am also returning the confidential form on [REDACTED] (Please note: the correct spelling is with a [REDACTED]) I have added what information I am able.

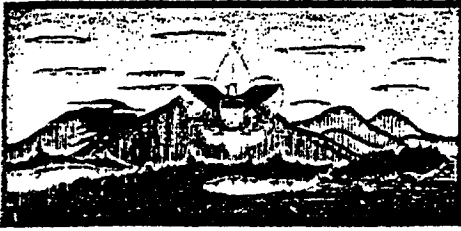

On August 21, 1990 at 8:30 a.m., I talked to Mr. Linwood Wiley, Scout Executive Council No. 382.


He indicated that [REDACTED] had moved out of the area and he did not know where he had located. He is going to try and track him down through the military and; perhaps, will have an easier time getting a statement now that he is no longer in that particular location. We will continue to attempt to receive this information so that we have a stronger file.

I indicated to Mr. Wiley that we could put Mr. Maxson on our file as a probationary type case where we would notify the Scout Executive should he attempt registration in some other area. This is the only recourse we will have, if we cannot get more solid information related to the attempted sexual advance.

In the meantime, I am holding this file until we hear from Mr. Wiley. After that we will request an Ineligible Volunteer Record Sheet.

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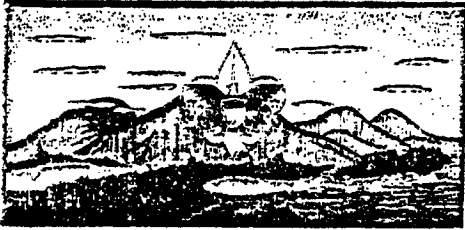

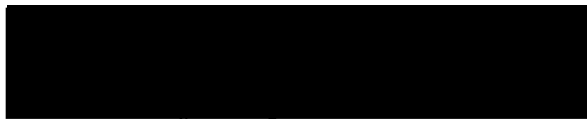

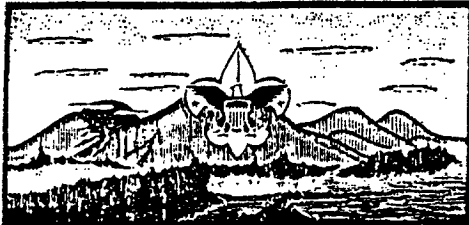

Please be advised that I have been approached by [REDACTED] an Exploring leader in the [REDACTED] regarding an incident involving himself and Bradley Maxson.

When [REDACTED] was thirteen (13) years old, he belonged to a Troop in which Bradley Maxson was a leader. [REDACTED] claims that Mr. Maxson made a sexual advance toward him.

At the time [REDACTED] says he did not understand the situation as he does now and he is coming forth with this information because of his recent involvement with the Explorer Post he is advising.

I have asked [REDACTED] to submit a letter to you explaining the incident and why he is bringing it to your attention at this time. He has agreed and requests that a copy of his letter be sent to the National Office.

I can vouch for the reliability of [REDACTED]. He has a solid educational background including a Master's Degree from [REDACTED]. He also has served as a [REDACTED] in the [REDACTED]. He is currently serving as Commander of the [REDACTED] of the [REDACTED] in [REDACTED].

Please keep me advised of this matter.
