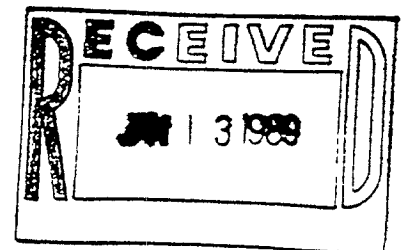

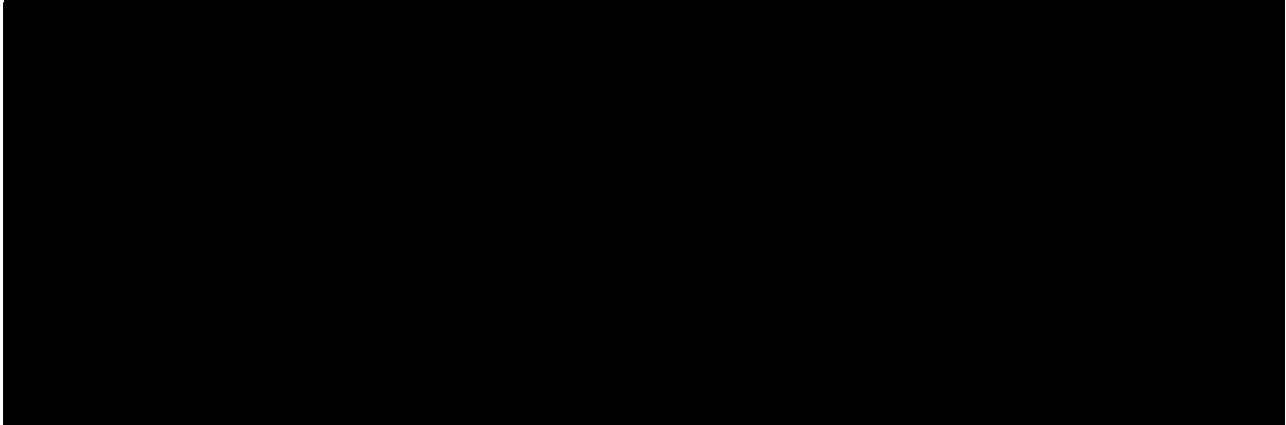

Applicant Procedure for Requesting Review
of Decision Denying Registration

1. If registration is refused, the applicant may request a review of this decision. This request must be in the form of a written request from the individual which includes his or her version of the facts supporting the claim that registration should not have been denied.
2. Upon receipt of the written request for review, the president of the local council shall appoint a committee to review the situation.
3. The appointed committee shall have the right to be heard, and in addition, may invite any persons whose testimony might assist the committee in discovering the truth and arriving at a just and equitable decision.
4. The applicant shall have the right to be heard and to present evidence in support of his or her case.
5. If the applicant is not satisfied with the decision of the committee, he or she may advise the council in writing of his or her reasons for not accepting the decision of the committee. The council shall then make a final decision.
