

Dear Mr. Bradley:

After careful review, we have decided that your registration with the Boy Scouts of America should be suspended. We are therefore compelled to request that you sever any relations you may have with the Boy Scouts of America. A refund of your registration fee is enclosed.

You should understand that BSA membership registration is a privilege and is not automatically granted to everyone who applies. We reserve the right to suspend registration whenever there is a concern that an individual may not measure up to the high standards of membership the BSA seeks to provide for American youth.

If you wish to have this decision reviewed, please write to me within 60 days of the date of this letter, explaining your version of the facts supporting your claim that your registration as a BSA member should be reinstated. The procedures for review are attached.

MEMORANDUM OF CONVERSATION WITH
CARL BRADLEY

September 21, 1989 4:45 - 5:00 p.m.

Present: Jerry Hasting, Scout Executive
Ted Soliday, Vice President, Program
Carl Bradley

Location: Council Service Center

Jerry informed Carl of decision to sever relationship with Scouting because of limited information we have received. Jerry read letter to Carl. Discussed refund of fee and review process.

Carl disclosed that he had done "something he was very ashamed of 11-12 years ago." The incident was indecent liberties with a young girl. Never had a problem with boys. He is presently in a divorce process with his wife. She has involved CPS.

Carl indicated that he understood what we needed to do and that he was willing to immediately separate himself from Scouting. He felt as though he had "paid his dues" for his problem when he was "messed up for a couple of weeks."

Carl asked if we would contact Pat Haveman, Committee Chairman, to let her know he would not be involved. Jerry indicated he would and that a Unit Commissioner was already assigned to assist with tonight's school night.

Ted explained that a review process is available, but our first concern is for the youth and the program.

Carl refused to take the letter from the Council President, the refund check or review process info sheet.

Jerry held the "packet" out to Carl's hand and asked again if he would take them. He refused, put down on the table his own envelope and said "Here is my final SME payment, I'm all paid up." He turned and left the office and building.

NOTES CONCERNING CARL BRADLEY

- August 25, 1989 (Friday) Message left for Scout Executive at Council Service Center from [REDACTED] concerning her husband (divorce in process). Her message was that Carl Bradley was "registered with Child Protective Services, CPS."
- August 28, 1989 (Monday) Scout Executive able to contact [REDACTED] in the late afternoon. She indicated the following:
- ° 12-15 years ago, Carl was court-martialed as a Ltjg in the U. S. Navy at NAS Whidbey for child molestation. Incident was with a young girl. This happened prior to her meeting Carl.
 - ° She recently discovered his past, learned how he "operated," and could see the same patterns starting with [REDACTED].
 - ° Carl is "registered" with CPS.
 - ° Carl is CM, Pack 47, ten years, no boys of own in program.
- August 29, 1989 (Tuesday) Contacted Ward McKinsey, supervisor at CPS to explain the situation. When I gave him Carl's name, he immediately recognized it, put me on hold, came back and indicated that there was a "case currently open" on Carl Bradley. He was not able to disclose any further information, but would have the case worker contact me.
- August 29, 1989 (Tuesday) Contacted Legal Services at NAS Whidbey re: court-martial. They do not keep cases over three years. Gave me a phone number of Judge Advocate General's office in Washington, D.C. Was advised that without Social Security Number, etc., would have difficult time getting information.
- August 30, 1989 (Wednesday) Consulted with Council President.
- August 30, 1989 (Wednesday) Call from Kris Hurlburt, CSP case worker. Kris was not able to give details of any kind as we did not have clearance from Carl Bradley. Gave Kris phone number of JAG in D.C. She would follow up.
- Kris said "There is concern and it is not going to go away."
- August 30, 1989 (Wednesday) Contacted Claude Yamamoto, Area Director. Indicated that we were preparing to act, did he concur? He did.
- August 31, 1989 (Thursday) Cut check for refund, consulted with Council President, prepared letter, etc.
- September 1, 1989 (Friday) Started what turned out to be a long process to contact Carl Bradley. (Pack was inactive during this time.)
- ° Called listed phone number [REDACTED] over several days. Eventually was answered. This was the home of Carl's daughter. Carl did not live there. Was told that they did not know how to contact Carl.

° Called Pack Committee Chairman, Pat Haveman. She gave me a new phone number [REDACTED]. Called again over several days including over six hours on Saturday, September 9. This was done in the office of Council Vice President Ted Soliday. Ted was prepared to call on Carl with me on that day.

Repeated calls to that number finally resulted in an answer on September 14. This was the home of [REDACTED]. She did not know how to contact Carl except through his work. She told me that he works for [REDACTED] in Lynden.

° Called Johnny Fence on Friday, September 15, and left message for Carl to contact me.

° Called Johnny Fence on Tuesday evening about 4:30. Again left message. They gave me Carl's home phone number [REDACTED].

° Called new number Tuesday. No answer. Called Wednesday evening, got recording device, left message for Carl to contact me.

° Pat Haveman, Committee Chairman, came into office. J. Blake, District Executive, and I met with her to explain that Carl is being asked to sever all ties with Scouting. She indicated that Carl was going to attend their school night on Thursday (next day).

September 21, 1989 (Thursday) Called Johnny Fence again with message for Carl to call me "prior to school night."

Carl called while I was out. Office Manager set up 4:30 p.m. meeting at Scout Service Center. Contacted Ted Soliday to be here by 4:15.
