Please be advised that I have been retained by the parents of [REDACTED] in connection with an incident which occurred at your camp on or about August 5 or 6, 1988.

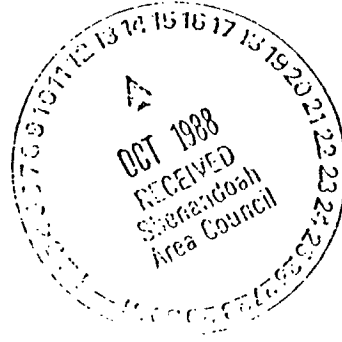

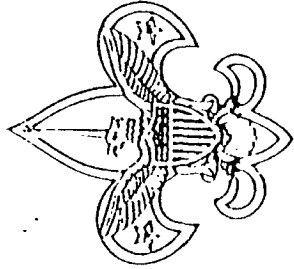

That's all for now.

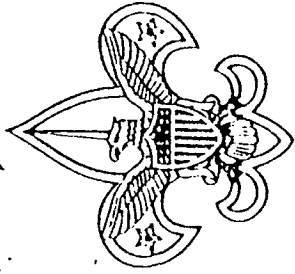

MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

REVIEW COMMITTEE

COLUMBIA PACIFIC COUNCIL - BOY SCOUTS OF AMERICA

SUBJECT: Registration of Carleton "Tim" Coffey

THE UNDERSIGNED, constituting the Committee appointed by the Council President to review an appeal by Carleton "Tim" Coffey, has reviewed carefully the material submitted to us by the Council Scout Executive in this matter.

Our review included a review of public records including court records relating to the case entitled State of Oregon v. Carleton Timothy Coffey, in the Multnomah County Circuit Court, Case No. C-85-03-30861; District Attorney Case No. 292969 as well as the applicable standards set out in the "Procedures For Maintaining Standards of Membership", (and particularly Appendix "D" thereto) published by the Boy Scouts of America under publication No. 57-105.

The Committee noted that all members of the Boy Scouts of America are registered for a limited period and must re-register at the end of that registration term. A registration is not effective unless approved by both the local Council and the National Office.


The Committee noted it was not the Committee's responsibility to determine whether the applicant was a decent citizen. The Committee's responsibility was to determine whether or not a denial of the applicant's registration was appropriate.


It is the Committee's decision that the denial is appropriate in view of the applicant's acknowledged prior conduct which, according to the public record in the above-described criminal court case, resulted in a conviction of a felony involving moral turpitude in which the victim was a minor child under the age of 12 years.


In view of the foregoing it is our opinion that the applicant does not possess the moral or emotional qualities necessary to afford positive leadership to youth and should not therefore be registered as a member of the Boy Scouts of America.

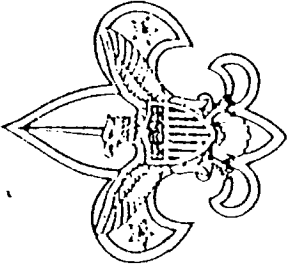

Dear Mr. Coffey,

After careful review, we have decided that your registration with the Boy Scouts of America should be suspended. We are therefore compelled to request that you sever any relations you may have with the Boy Scouts of America. A refund of your registration fee is enclosed.

You should understand that BSA membership registration is a privilege and is not automatically granted to everyone who applies. We reserve the right to suspend registration whenever there is a concern that an individual may not measure up to the high standards of membership the BSA seeks to provide for American youth.

If you wish to have this decision reviewed, please write to me within 60 days of the date of this letter, explaining your version of the facts supporting your claim that your registration as a BSA member should be granted or reinstated. The procedures for review are attached.

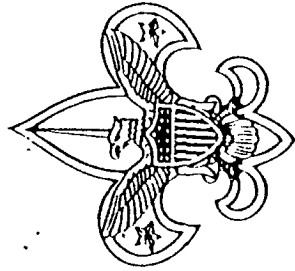


APPLICANT PROCEDURE FOR REQUESTING REVIEW  
OF DECISION DENYING REGISTRATION

1. If registration is refused, the applicant may request a review of this decision. This request must be in the form of a written request from the individual which includes his or her version of the facts supporting the claim that registration should not have been denied.
2. Upon receipt of the written request for review, the president of the local council shall appoint a committee to review the situation.
3. The appointed committee should review the facts as presented, and, in addition, may interview any persons whose testimony might assist the committee in discovering the truth and arriving at a correct decision.
4. A confidential report will be given to the applicant setting forth the decision of the committee.
5. The applicant may - if he or she does not agree with the decision - request a review from the regional director by submitting a written request for such a review within 30 days of the receipt of the local council decision.
6. If the regional review does not satisfy the applicant, he or she may ask for further review by the National Council by submitting a written request for such a review within 30 days of the receipt of the regional decision. The decision by the National Council is final.

I am asking that you send Mr. Coffey a letter suspending his registration and indicating that he cannot be registered in the future with the Boy Scouts of America. I believe this is the proper way to go after discussing this matter with management in the national office.

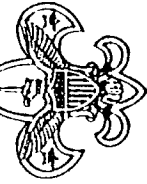

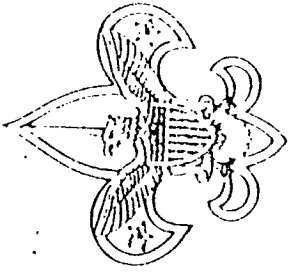

Dear Don:

This is in response to your letter of December 2nd concerning the above-named individual. I appreciate the material which you sent us, as it is very helpful to us in evaluating the situation.

Based on the information which I have read, I assume this is basically a matter of incest, since I assume that this individual was either a daughter or a step-daughter. According to the information that was sent, there apparently were no involvements with other youth.

You asked how we should handle this, and at the present time, I would respond that I do not think he should be registered. My concern is that any relationship with Scouting will eventually lead to relationship with youth in some manner. This may not be a normal relationship in the sense of being a position that normally deals with youth, but sooner or later we all become involved with youth in one way or another if we are involved in Scouting. I also am deeply concerned as to the reaction of parents when they learn that this situation has occurred, and we still have an individual serving as an adult leader.

I would, of course, abide by your final decision in the council, but my recommendation would be that we try to phase the individual out in a kind manner and place him on the Confidential file, at least in a probationary situation. This would mean that he could register if he tried at a later time, but we would tell the Scout Executive of the council of the situation so that that council could make the necessary decisions related to using him as a volunteer.

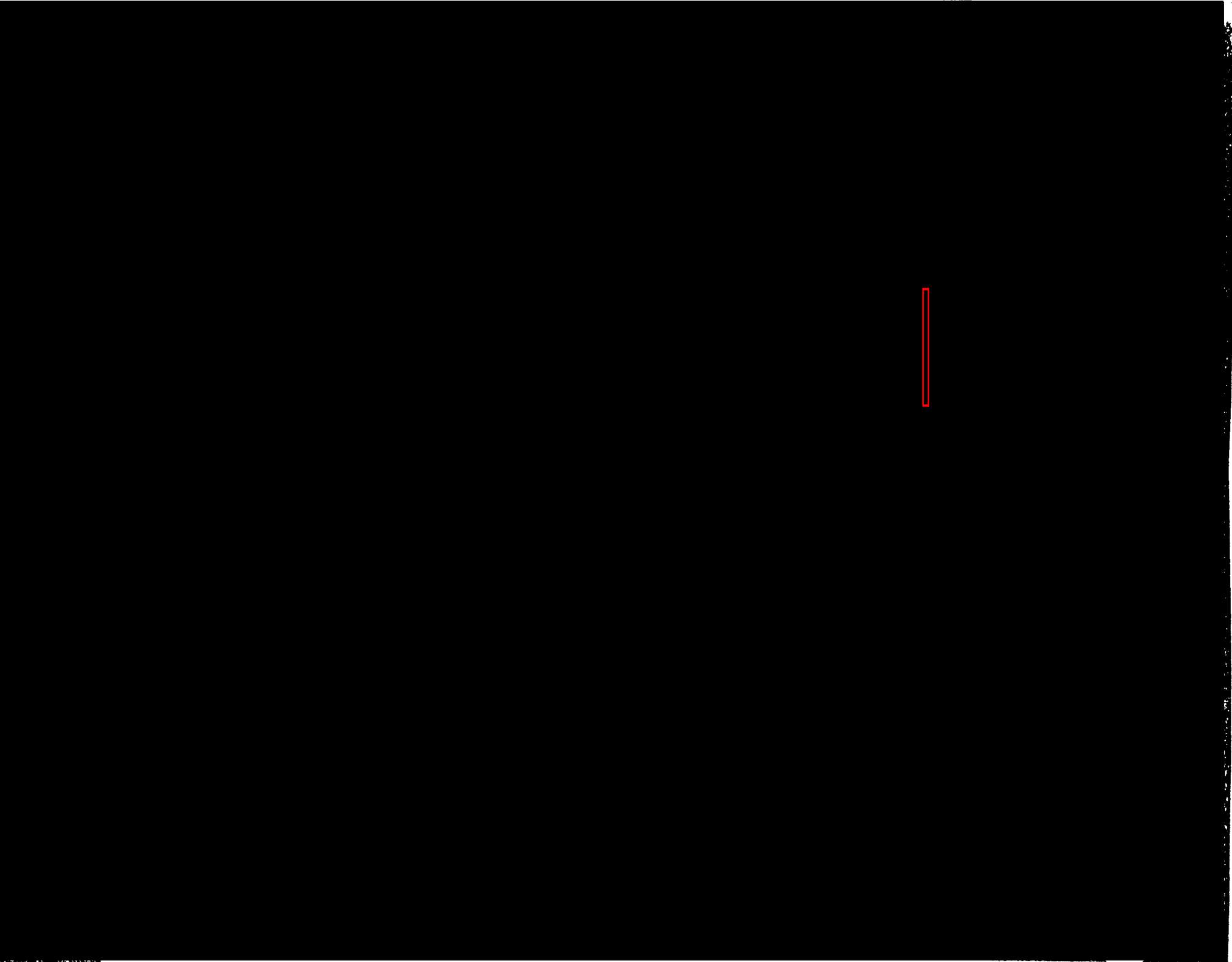
