It came to our attention that Mr. Helms has had three separate incidents that were reported to the police over the past two years.

Number 1: During the Superbowl of 1990, Mr. Helms allegedly attempted to help a small boy go to the bathroom by getting the boy into a stall with him. The boy protested, and Mr. Helms said he was just trying to help.

Number 2: Friends of Mr. Helms had questioned his relationship with their son who was a Cub Scout. This incident was stated to the South Elgin Police by Mr. Helms himself.

Number 3: In a one-to-one meeting with a young boy believed to be in his Cub Pack, Mr. Helms allegedly asked the boy if he knew what a prophylactic was and if he knew how to put one on. This incident was reported to the South Elgin Police, but the parents refused to press charges.
