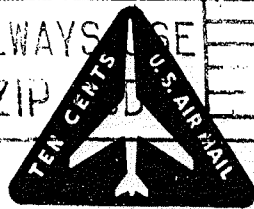

In your Chicago area you have an employee, one Charles Frank Jones who attended school in New Brunswick from January through May of 1962.

One of the first rules of your organization is that a man be married. Charles Frank Jones is a homosexual with a United States Army record of a medical discharge from the Army the first week in April of 1961 or the last week in March. The discharge was given on the basis of a psycho-homosexual discharge, that his nature caused his mind to go berserk when the passion was not fulfilled with his own sex. He was discharged from Fort Ord, California.

Charles Jones was also fired-released from his job working with young children in Chicago, the year of 1963 between May and July from a Recreational Center located at 21st and Michigan Avenue.

This man was broke up for the same reason, and he decided for an immoral homosexual type marriage went to his death his wife was friend at 6350 South Parkway in July 1963. Witnesses in Chicago of why he decided his wife was gone would be at 6214 So Michigan Avenue. He has two arrest records and other charges, in Chicago July 1964 and late April or early May 1965.

Charles Frank Jones was also released from his job in Santa Barbara, California, Governor School where he was around young children in June of 1962. This can also be verified the way it is on the record.

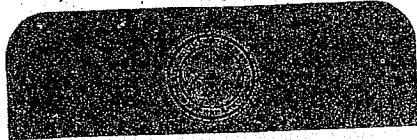

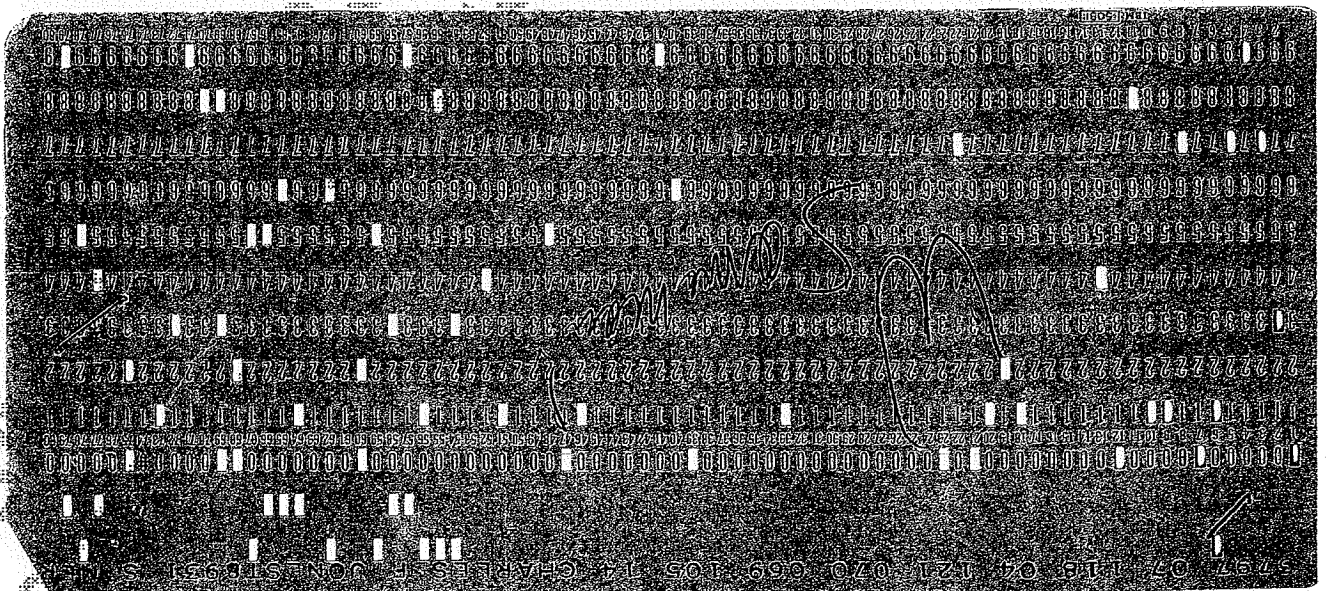
