A former Everett school bus driver already facing allegations he molested two neighborhood children was charged Wednesday with taking indecent liberties with two more children on his school bus.

The new charges conclude what prosecutors had described as a "major child sexual abuse investigation" into the activities of Charles S. Grewe, 30, of Everett.

When Grewe was first charged in June, prosecutors said they were looking into complaints filed by a half-dozen Silver Lake Elementary School fifth-graders who alleged Grewe molested them on his bus.

Wednesday's Snohomish County Superior Court charges allege Grewe took indecent liberties with two young girls in incidents between March and May, according to deputy prosecutor Diane Hess. The court papers provide few other details of the investigation, however.

Grewe drove a bus for Durham Transportaion of Washington Inc., which worked under contract for the Everett School District. A company spokesman said after the initial charges were filed that Grewe was no longer driving a bus for the firm.

No trial date has been set on the new allegations.

Grewe is still awaiting trial on the earlier, unrelated charges that he took indecent liberties with two neighborhood children. He had pleaded innocent to the allegations.

An 8-year-old neighbor girl told investigators that Grewe molested her on two occasions since last Christmas when she visited his home, deputy prosecutor Michael Downes said.

A 10-year-old girl witnessed one of the alleged incidents, telling sheriff's detectives she saw Grewe touching the younger girl "all over," the prosecutor said.

A 6-year-old neighbor also told a sheriff's interviewer that Grewe once offered him a lollipop and cocoa and asked to touch the boy's private areas, the prosecutor said.

Prosecutor Downes said Grewe also has been actively involved in Boy Scout activities and outings, but the charges are unrelated to those activities.

Driver of school bus probed in sex abuse

A 30-year-old Everett school bus driver is the target of "a major child sexual abuse investigation" involving complaints by at least a half-dozen fifth-graders who say be molested them on his bus, prosecutors said Tuesday,

Chartes S. Grewe of Everett was charged Tuescay in Snohomist County Superior Court with two unrelated counts of taking indecent liberties with two aeighborhood children.

Grewe is being held on \$25,000 bail and was scheduled to be arraigned today.

He drove a bus for Durham Transportation of Washington inc., which worked under contract for the Everett School District. A company spokeswoman said Grewe was no longer driving a bus but declined further contract.

According to deputy prosecutor Micnae: Downes, Grewe also has been actively involved in Boy Scout activities and outlings.

Shohomish County sheriff's investigators reterred one case to Skagit County authorities involving acts allegedly commuted with a youth at a Scout camp in that county, according to the court papers.

Grewe was charged Tuesday with Exing indecent liberties with an 8-year-old neighoor girl. The Evereti girl told investigators that Grewe molested her on two occasions succe last Christmas when she was visiting he norme. Downes said.

A 10-year-old girl witnessed one of the alieged incidents, teiling speriff sofficers she saw Grewe touching the younger girl "all over," the prosecutor said. ~

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A 6-year-old neighbor boy also told a soartif's interviewer that on one occasion at the man's home, Grewe offered him a lollipop and cocoa and asked if he could touch the boy's private areas.

The boy said he refused but Grewe touched him anyway, the prosecutor alleged.

The broader investigation began after. "at least six members" of a fifth-grade class reported being sexually motosted while on Grewe's school bus.

"The Snonomist: County Sheriff's Office is in the process of investigating the school bus incidents." Downer said in a court affidavit. "It does appear at this time, however, extremely likely that another multiple-court, multiple-victim case will soon be filed against the defendant."

Sheriff's spokesman Elliou Woodail lauded school officials today, saying they "acted immediately and responsibly as soon as they knew of a complaint." He said school officials confacted his department immediately after allegations were raised.

Downes said he will request that Grewe's ball not be lowered when Grewe appears today in court. It.is expected to be at least two weeks before any additional charges are prepared, he said

Attached is the Confidential Record Sheet for Charles Grewe, along with the letter that we've given him suspending his membership in the Boy Scouts of America. Attached to the Confidential Record Sheet are the notes of the interview I had with Doug Shaw, Scoutmaster of Troop 49, who related the feelings of the parents that their the second second by Grewe while learning to swim.

The Council President and I met with Charles Grewe today and gave him the standard letter along with the information on how to appeal this decision if he chose to do so.

Lee Pintar explained very briefly to Mr. Grewe that some accusations by a parent had been made about him, possibly molesting their child at camp last summer and that we were now following the standard procedure outlined by the BSA. Charles said he understood the procedure and denied that he had done anything wrong to any boy, wanted to know the details, but we told him that we could not discuss details with him and the matter had been turned over to the Skagit County police. They would investigate the matter at this point and gather the facts from the parents and the boy as well as from Grewe to ascertain what had happened and whether the charges are substantiated.

Charles sat very quietly for a long period of time to gather his thoughts and said he probably would want to appeal this. We then told Charles how sorry we were to convey this to him because he had been a respected member of the Scouting community. This matter would be kept confidential and we would not share this with anyone including his employer. Charles finished by saying, "I guess there is really nothing to talk about" and left at that point.

This matter was turned over to the Skagit Police March 18 and by that afternoon they had made a contact with the parents. There have been subsequent calls to the Skagit Police Department and there have been no contacts with the parents. Next week they will assign an officer to investigate the charges.



These are the basic facts in the situation to date and when we have further information, we will keep you apprised. Last week when our Area Director, Claude Yamamoto, was in town, we shared this information with Claude.

INTERVIEW NOTES

Regarding: Charles Grewe

On March 18, 1988 at 10:15 a.m. I conducted an interview with Doug Shaw, Scoutmaster of Troop 49, Alderwood Manor, WA 98036, Also present was Richard Szymanski, Puget Sound District Executive, who had been called on March 17.

Doug Shaw reported he had telephoned boys in his troop concerning signing up to go to camp with Troop 49. Said he did not want to go back this summer. When Doug Shaw asked why, Said mother, Said he did not want to go back this that Charles Grewe fondled shaw why, while teaching him to swim (chest and private areas), all done in the water.

The boy asked Charles to stop after the first time. Charles apologized, but it happened after that once or twice more. Leaders from the troop, now reflecting back, while in camp felt the boy's emotional state changed and he stayed in his tent most of Thursday and Friday.
