

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

Thanks for your response and the copy of the Scouter application for Charles Vernon Wall, who you say is currently registered as Committee an of Troop 73 in Hyde Park. Well yes, I guess he is because when Troop 73 reregistered last October he went through okay and received a certificate.

The situation was not brought to our attention until the following month, November, 1967. At that time we deleted his name as a registered Scouter in Troop 73 from our records and put him on the file to prevent his future reregistration, but as is usual in cases of this type, beyond advising you that we were putting him on the file, we did not then, nor do we now recommend any action to take his registration certificate away from him. You are absolutely right, we open curselves up to legal entanglements when we take action of this type. So, your Buffalo experience stands you in good stead.

Do nothing, except do not under any circumstances encourage this individual in any manner and if you should happen to know some of the key people in Troop 73, you might quietly indicate to them that there is a problem in connection with him and that National Council has advised you that it will not accept any application for reregistration by Wall.

The reason I wrote you as I recently did is because back in November of 1967 after rather considerable correspondence with George Darlington, I got a note back from him which said "He is still here Going strong. Wonder if there are 2 Charles Walls?". Then this April I received additional information which prompted me to write you on the 22nd. I wanted you to know that he shouldn't be "going strong" and that there are not 2 Charles Walls, and that you should be on the alert against any activities on his part and that you and we should and will refuse his reregistration.

We have recently had additional information concerning one Charles Vernon Hall. You recall that he was the individual who at one time lived at 436 N.E. 17th Way, Fort Lauderdale, Florida.

Without going into a great deal of background, let me simply say that we have Mr. Wall listed in such a capacity that we are unwilling to accept his registration in the Boy Scouts of America.

We now have information that Wall keeps writing to the Scoutmaster of the troop he served with in Florida indicating that although he was kicked out of Scouting in Florida, he is now actively engaged in New York. Is it possible that he has become registered in your council and that his registration slipped by us? Or is it possible that he is serving "unofficially" in some capacity, but is not actually registered?

Would you please check on this and let me know in what capacity Charles Wall is serving in your council and, if he is serving in any capacity, official or otherwise, may I recommend that you terminate his services as quickly and as diplomatically as possible because in our judgment he should not be actively associated in a program dealing with boys.

Dear Howard:

Back on November 10, 1967 you wrote injuring about an application you had received for Charles Vernon Wall, who's current address at that time was Haviland Apartments, No. 7, Route 9-G, Hyde Park, N. Y. Your letter indicated that he was applying to serve as a committeeman in Troop 73, Hyde Park, N. That he was 30 years of age... a teacher in the Hyde Park School System...single ... and a Protestant.

The reason you wrote me was that your information indicated he had been registered as an assistant Scoutmaster, Fort Lauderdale, Fla. You asked if I could give you information which might effect your thinking concerning the willingness to accept Mr. Wall's application for registration as a leader. I responded on November 27 by saying that "several people have expressed concern about this man being immoral around boys." Also, I indicated that the Broward County School System had cause to wonder, and it was my understanding that they would not re-hire him because of homosexual tendencies.

Howard, this fellow wall keeps writing to the Scoutmaster of the troop he served with, indicating that although he was kicked out of Scouting in Florida he is now actively engaged in New York. I don't know the fellow personally, but he certainly can't be much of a guy to move to New York and go through all the effort of writing back to his former troop rubbing in the fact that he is still in Scouting. Frankly, I would go on record of putting him on the "Confidential List" and saying, "a bad apple" and letting it go at that.
