Due to recent personal events, I felt it was necessary to come forward and disclose some actions taken by the Scout master of troop # 243, Clyde Swearingin. As close as I can recall, these events occurred during the winter of 1981-82.

While on a non scouting Campout at Mr Swearingin's Cabin, I was Sexually molested. These Molestations included physical contact of my genitals and oral sex by Mr Swearingin. Due to feelings of respect, and concern I had for this individual I accepted his apology and promise that this would never happen again. At that time, before this incident we had shared basically a father son type of relationship. Unfortunately, this incident occurred again, this time during the Boy Scout Christmas Campout during the winter of 81 while the troop was staying at The Rangers house. At that time I guess I still believed his apology to be sincere and was afraid of reporting his actions for fear of what it might

do to him and his career, at this point he still was teaching.

Within the past two months I have met with Mr Swearingin to confront him with what he did to me, and ask him if he still was or had done this to anyone else. To both of these questions I received an astute "NO?" and felt I could believe him and was satisfied that I had dealt with and resolved the matter. Two weeks after this, I had a chance to talk to my Brother, [REDACTED] who had just returned from Texas. At this time [REDACTED] informed me that he too was molested by Mr. Swearingin. At this time I chose to approach Mr. Bowman and inform him of these actions. My motive for disclosing this information is to remove Mr Swearingin from scouting and to spare other individuals from the emotional burden I have carried the past 8 to 9 years.

Dear Clyde:

After careful review, we have decided that your registration with the Boy Scouts of America should be suspended. We are therefore compelled to request that you sever any relations you may have with the Boy Scouts of America.

You should understand that B.S.A. membership registration is a privilege and is not automatically granted to everyone who applies. We reserve the right to suspend registration whenever there is a concern that an individual may not measure up to the high standards of membership the B.S.A. seeks to provide for American youth.

If you wish to have this decision reviewed, please write to me within 60 days of the date of this letter, explaining your version of the facts supporting your claim that your registration as a B.S.A. member should be granted or reinstated. The procedures for review are attached.

APPLICANT PROCEDURE FOR REQUESTING REVIEW
OF DECISION DENYING REGISTRATION

1. If registration is refused, the applicant may request a review of this decision. This request must be in the form of a written request from the individual which includes his or her version of the facts supporting the claim that registration should not have been denied.
2. Upon receipt of the written request for review, the president of the local council shall appoint a committee to review the situation.
3. The appointed committee should review the facts as presented, and, in addition, may interview any persons whose testimony might assist the committee in discovering the truth and arriving at a correct decision.
4. A confidential report will be given to the applicant setting forth the decision of the committee.
5. The applicant may--if he or she does not agree with the decision--request a review from the regional director by submitting a written request for such a review within 30 days of the receipt of the local council decision.
6. If the regional review does not satisfy the applicant, he or she may ask for further review by the National Council by submitting a written request for such a review within 30 days of the receipt of the regional decision. The decision by the national Council is final.
