He was sentenced to penitentiary confinement for seven (7) years. Counts 3, 5 and 6 were dismissed on Motion of the Commonwealth.

Teacher charged with 3 sex-related counts, other charges pending

A Madisonville man remains in the Hopkins County Detention Center today in lieu of bonds totaling \$30,000 (\$10,000 on each charge) on three sex-related charges. In the detention center today is Coley

Tidwell Carl, 39, 350 Dempsey St.

Carl is charged with one count of sodomy in the first degree, one count of sodomy in the second degree and one count of sexual abuse in the first degree.

According to arresting officers Kentucky State Police detective Mike Winn

and Hopkins County Deputy Sheriff Wayne Thomas, it is possible other sex-relater charges may be placed against Carl.

Winn said he and Thomas arrested Carabout 2 p.m. Monday at Earlington School where he taught the seventh and eightigrades.

At Monday night's Hopkins County Board of Education meeting, the school board voted unanimously to immediately suspend Carl from his teaching duties pending disposition of charges against him

Winn said the investigation of Carrevealed that the alleged incidents occurred over a period of about a year with boys between the ages of 12 and 14.

Winn said Carl's arrest yesterday was the result of an investigation of Carl by state and county officials based on information supplied them by parents of the boys.

The state police detective, who declined to comment further on Carl's arrest, said Carl was an assistant scoutmaster of a Boy Scout troop in Earlington.

Upon his arrest yesterday, a preliminary hearing was set for Caff in Hopkins County Court Dec. 2, however, since the Hopkins County grand futy meets again Monday, Winn said he expects that the grand jury will investigate Caff's charges.

According to Kentucky's penal code, sodomy in the first degree is a Class B felony, which carries; upon Editivition a penalty of prison for 10 to 20 years; a fine or both. Sodomy in the second degree is a Class C felony, which carries approach viction, a penalty of prison for 5 to 10 years; a fine or both. New sex-related counts are filed against man

Additional sex-related charges have been filed against a Madisonville man, according to Kentucky State Police detective Mike Winn.

Winn said this morning that three counts of sexual abuse in the first degree have been filed against Coley Tidwell Carl, 39, 350 Dempsey St.

The state police detective said bond on each count has been set at \$10,000, totaling \$30,000.

Winn said the charges stem from alleged sexual activity with three girls, all of whom were under 12 years of age.

Cari was arrested about 2 p.m. Monday at Earlington School, where he taught the seventh and eighth grades, by Winn and Hopkins County Deputy Sheriff Wayne Thomas and charged with one count of sodomy in the first degree and one count of sodomy in the second degree. Yesterday, an additional sex-related charge was filed against Cari, sexual abuse in the first degree, and this warrant was read to him in the Hopkins County Detention Center, where he remains today in lieu of bonds totaling \$60,000 on the six charges against him.

According to detective Winn, the first hree charges filed against him allegedly

occurred over a period of about a year with boys between the ages of 12 and 14.

Reader reminder: Guilt or innocence should not be presumed prior to trial or disposition of charges.
