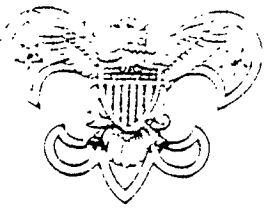



Special Probationary Conditions: All monetary obligations hereafter imposed shall be paid through the office of the Multnomah County Circuit Court Administrator [REDACTED] [REDACTED] Portland, Oregon 97204 as follows: defendant shall pay \$50.00 penalty assessment to the victims' fund within 90 days of sentencing; he shall pay a compensatory fine to the victim's mother as set forth above at the direction of his probation officer; the court recommends that the monthly probation supervision fee be waived. Further, he shall pay for any counseling of the victim in this matter, including transportation to and from same, in an amount and manner to be determined by his probation officer.

Defendant shall enroll in, successfully participate in and successfully complete a therapy program and counseling for Sexual Offenders as directed by his probation officer.
