However, as of yesterday morning, the Sheriff's Department's Juvenile Investigations' Bureau had not filed child-molesting charges in the district attorney's office.

"I talked to him all the time and thought he was wonderful," she said. "He had real good contact with (my son). He was always calling him and taking him places, and could barely control herself when he put him in his Scout troop. He

Dick Arbenz, executive director of the Los Angeles office of Big Brothers of America, declined comment on the mother's earlier complaint.

"Generally speaking, if a mother calls with any kind of concern. period, we look into it fully." Arbenz said. "If she complains he parts his hair the wrong way we'll investigate it, and we (end the relationship) if the mother is not happy."

The mother said she never suspected anything sinister, and in fact scolded her son.

"I was angry with him. I told him, 'Craig has gone out of his way for you and you're just not treating him right," she said.

joined Mathias' Scout troop, his attitude changed, she said. He won several merit badges and was enthusiastic.

But three months ago, she said, he suddenly told her he wanted to quit the Scout troop.

"I told him I didn't understand why he wanted to quit," she said. "I kept harping on it. I was really disappointed in him and I didn't want him to disappoint Craig again. He said, 'Mom, I just don't like it."

Eventually, she said, the boy became so worked up that "he'd liter-

Detectives tapped her phone, she said, and told her that if the suspect Eight months ago, when he called, she should put her son on the phone. "Try and get it all out of him, to admit what he had done." they told her.

If he didn't call, police told her to have the boy call him.

"I was worried about all the emotions, but I told him to go ahead (and call)," she said. "I wanted to get it over with. I didn't want to drag it on any more.

"He felt like he was huning his friend, but it was kind of an adventure," she said. "After it was over he said, 'I think I'm going to be a detective."

"As the aircraft came over the runway, the left wing was low and the pilot was unable to get the wing up," Zappa said. "The wing hit and the aircraft cartwheeled into the ground, catching fire immediately afterward."

The Associated Press reported that several witnesses saw what appeared to be a fuel leak as the plane took off. After the crash, the witnesses said they saw a frantic woman at the accident scene shouting, "My daughter's in there. Please do something, those are our children," the news service reported.
