Pursuant to our telephone conversation, I am enclosing file copies of incident involving one Dale Kelleher, of our Council.

We have been unable to obtain a meeting with Kelleher and primarily have only the outraged parents account of the incident.

We suspended registration and repeatedly sought a meeting by telephone and correspondence. We have had no response whatsoever.

Kelleher was visiting with a troop at Camporee when incident took place. His registration was with an inactive Explorer Post that was to drop at expiration date.

His conduct was unquestionably out-of-order and his refusal to explain his actions did not allow us to get the full story.

Kelleher is not involved in Scouting in our Council.

We have made necessary reports to Dept. of Social Services.

Dear Chief Gouvain,

This letter is in regards to the incident which occurred on October 14, 1989 at Camp Morse. As Unit Leader, and involved parent, it becomes my duty to inform you that [REDACTED] was assaulted and threatened at camp by (Matt) Dale Kelleher, an adult.

Mr. Kelleher grabbed [REDACTED] by the upper thigh while "wrestling", causing bruises. This was preceded by Mr. Kelleher telling [REDACTED] that he thought [REDACTED] would be a "good kisser", thereupon kissing [REDACTED] on the cheek. Also, during this incident, Mr. Kelleher uttered threats of sodomy to [REDACTED] (a 12-year old boy).

I, therefore, conclude from these facts, that this matter should be turned over to the proper authorities for their investigation. I feel Mr. Kelleher must be investigated promptly for the safety and welfare of all scouts and children in our area.

Because of this incident, [REDACTED] has been to the doctor

has expressed the desire to pursue this situation in court or any other way or manner that he can to stop this from happening


to another youth.

Dear Mr. Kelleher:

After careful review, we have decided that your registration with the Boy Scouts of America should be suspended. We are therefore compelled to request that you sever any relations that you may have with the Boy Scouts of America. A refund of your registration fee is enclosed.

You should understand that BSA membership registration is a privilege and is not automatically granted to everyone who applies. We reserve the right to suspend registration whenever there is a concern that an individual may not meet the high standards of membership which the BSA seeks to provide for American youth.

If you wish to have this decision reviewed by a council review committee, please write to me within 60 days of the date of this letter, explaining your version of the facts supporting your claim that your registration as a BSA member should be reinstated. The procedures for a review of this decision are attached.
