In 1986 the Troop 137 asked me to attend a troop committee meeting, because of gossip in the small community of New Manchester, West Virginia about Dale Thomas Brant. At this meeting his mother and Dale himself were present, and everything was just praise for his work. It was decided that the troop committee find out who is spreading these rumors and get them to stop. The Cub Pack received the blame for starting these rumors, that Dale Thomas Brant was a homosexual. The following month I approached the pack adult leaders, very carefully, to find only that they thought very highly of Mr. Brant. Everything calmed down for about four or five months. Then the committee asked for my presence again at an Eagle Court of Honor. While attending the Scoutmaster and one other committeeman insisted that the council must do something about Mr. Brant. He ran the Troop Court of Honor that night and I returned their questions with questions of my own. What has he done? No one gave me an answer, except he doesn't date girls, he takes scouts from the troop to movies. Has he made any advances towards these scouts was answered with, we don't know.
