Lodi man accused of child molesting

Dan Meeks, 37, of 350 S. Ham Lane, Apt. 19, yesterday was arrested on charges of lascivious conduct with a child, steming from a reported incident involving the molesting of a 12-year-old Lodi boy.

Meeks, a Boy Scout leader, posted a \$3,000 bail bond and was ordered to appear Monday in Lodi Municipal Court for arraignment.

According to Lodi Police Department, the incident occurred late last Friday in the boy's home. However, an arrest was not made until an investigation was completed.
