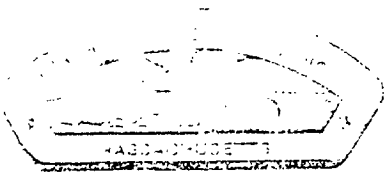

The above named individual was served a letter of Suspension and requested to desist from any and all Scouting affiliations effective May 28, 1986. Events leading to the suspension reportedly occurred and involved Scouts from Troop 81 North Andover, MA over a multi-year period.

Based on conversations reported by members of the Troop Committee, when confronted, the above named individual resigned without protest. It must be noted, the youth members declined to testify in court.

It is our contention that based on reported facts and actions thereby warrants the exclusion of Daniel R. McRobbie from all further affiliations with Scouting.

You should understand that BSA leadership registration is a privilege and is not automatically granted to everyone who applies. We reserve the right to suspend registration whenever there is a concern that an individual may not measure up to the high standards of leadership which the BSA seeks to provide for American youth. Please also understand that this decision and the reasons for it will be maintained as confidential.

If you wish to have this decision reviewed, please write to me, explaining your version of the facts supporting your claim that your registration as a BSA leader should be granted or reinstated.
