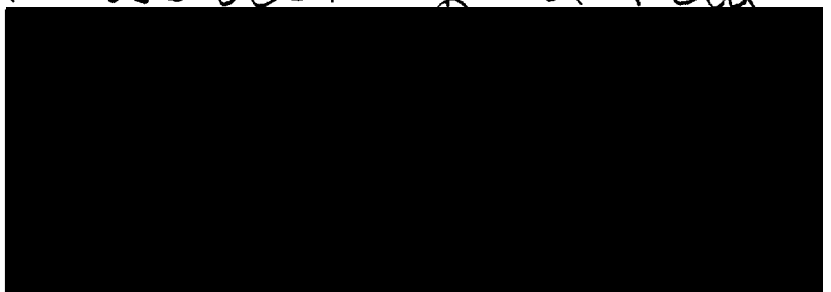



2 men held for lewd acts

WONDER VALLEY — An investigation into reports of sexual acts committed against two 11-year-old boys during a camping trip has led to the filing of charges against two Morongo Basin men, a spokesman for the San Bernardino County Sheriff's Department said Tuesday.

A complaint filed Monday by the District Attorney's office charges James Buckston, 42, of Twentynine Palms, with six counts of lewd and lascivious acts against a child and David Allen Reed, 46, of Wonder Valley, with four counts of the same crime, said Sheriff's Department Public Affairs Officer Jim Bryant.

The two were arrested Nov. 10 at Reed's residence at 4150 Gammel Road for investigation into the matter, said Bryant.

Both men are in custody in the Central County Jail in San Bernardino. Bail for Reed was set at \$100,000 while Buckston is being held on \$7,000 bail.

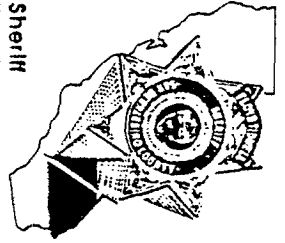

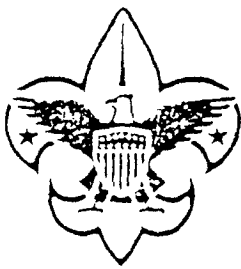

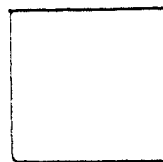

SUB: Report on delivery of President Tidwell's letters
to David A. Reed and James A. Buxton.

The letters were delivered by Sergeant Richard Van Der Wyk, he delivered and read the letters to Reed and Buxton at the same time.

They endorsed the checks and it was credited to their personal accounts at the jail.

David Reed and James Buxton requested that Detective Van Der Wyk take the letters and place them in the bag with their personal belongings, which are stored outside the jail.

The reason for this according to Detective Van Der Wyk is, that Buxton and Reed fear that these letters if on their person were found by other inmates, would probably cause them to be harmed. Apparently, child molesters are very unpopular in the jail community.
