

Former coach gets a year in jail for sex offenses

VERNON — A Superior Court judge this morning sentenced a 24-year-old former Rockville High School hockey coach to a year in jail and three years probation for engaging in sexual activities with two boys.

David C. Martin of Bolton Road, a former substitute teacher and Boy Scout leader, said nothing during his sentencing before Judge Allen Smith. His parents stood closely behind him and his lawyer, Leo Flaherty.

Flaherty had argued against incarcerating

Martin, who had pleaded guilty two counts of risk of injury to a minor, arguing that his client has suffered for the crimes committed with two boys over a period of two years.

Martin has lost a job, respect and has been "devastated" by the publicity of his arrest, Flaherty said. He also believes he will be a "marked man" if imprisoned, the lawyer said.

In arguing against incarceration, Flaherty offered several letters from people in local education, government and recreation fields who supported a suspended sentence for

Martin

"These are people who are most concerned about young people," the lawyer said. "This man's life has been a whole life of accomplishment."

But the judge was not swayed by the argument.

"I wonder how all these people who write all these glowing letters would feel if their young sons were involved," Smith said.

The judge said that when the mother of one of the victims told her father what had happened to his grandson, he died of a heart attack a half hour later.

Also, one of the victim's fathers is considering a civil suit in connection with the incidents, Smith said.

"I just don't see how society can be just ignored in what I consider this horrible relationship with two young boys," Smith said. "I can't give him a suspended sentence."

Local and state police from Troop C Barracks in Stafford arrested Martin on March 9.


According to Tolland County Assistant State's Attorney Terence Sullivan, one victim was 14 years old and had engaged in sexual acts with Martin for the past two years.

The other victim, age 15, also was involved with Martin for the past two years, Sullivan said. In addition, Martin provided beer and marijuana to the youth and allowed him to drive a car, the prosecutor said.

Martin, a graduate of Rockville High School and Trinity College, became head coach of the hockey team during the 1981-82 season. School Superintendent Edward Maher said after the arrest that Martin would not be reappointed as coach.

Martin was a substitute teacher at RHS and Vernon Center Middle School and was scoutmaster of Boy Scout Troop 280 in East Hartford, a position her resigned after his arrest.

Ex-Scout Leader Pleads Guilty

. VERNON — A 24-year-old Vernon man who was a Boy Scout leader in East Hartford and a hockey coach and substitute teacher at Rockville High School pleaded guilty Thursday to two counts lodged in connection with sexual encounters he had with two feenage boys.

David C. Martin of 433 Bolton Road pleaded guilty to risk of injury to a minor in exchange for the state's agreeing not to prosecute him on a charge of second-degree sexual assault, Assis-

tant State's Attorney Terence A. Sullivan said.

Sullivan said Martin is accused of having oral sex with two teenage boys who played on hockey teams he coached at Rockville High School. He declined to provide details of the incidents.

Martin knew each of the boys for at least two years, Sullivan he

said.

Police have said one incident occurred Feb. 18 and the other

late last year. Martin was arrested March 9.

Martin, who is free on \$10,000 bond, could receive a maximum of 10 years in prison, Sullivan said. He will recommend that Martin be sentenced to five years in prison, suspended after one year, followed by probation and counseling.

Martin is scheduled to be sentenced May 31.

Martin was leader of Boy Scout Troop 280 in East Hartford. He was hockey coach at the high school during the 1982-83 season and the 1983-84 season, which ended in February.

We would appreciate having the sentencing once it does take place. If this appears in the newspaper or if you could get a copy of the court record, these would help to strengthen our file for future reference.


