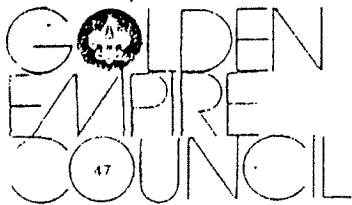

Dear Mr. Ernst:

On March 29, 1973 we sent you a personal and confidential letter attached to the registration card for the Rev. David E. Cates. That letter outlined certain facts pertaining to Father Cates which included a physical description of him and a request that his name be placed on the confidential list. We indicated in that letter that Father Cates had been convicted of certain felonies and is presently confined to the California State Medical Facility in Vacaville--a treatment center for the criminally insane.

On April 5 you sent us a letter acknowledging receipt of this information and a confidential record sheet which we filled out and returned to you within the same week. In May and again in July you sent repeat requests of this earlier April 5 letter, and yet on April 17 you sent us a letter which we have on file acknowledging receipt of the confidential record sheet. A photostat of this letter is attached.

I would sincerely appreciate if, in truth, the file on Father Cates is closed, ^{sending} and a letter to Calvin E. Wheelock, Scout Executive of this Council stating that you require no further information. If the file is not closed and you require further information on this case, would you please direct that inquiry to me immediately and I will answer any remaining questions that you may have.



Enclosed is a confidential record sheet which we would appreciate your filling out and returning to us as soon as possible, together with the above information.

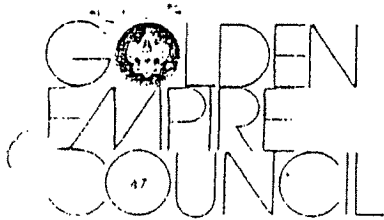
