

Witnesses who testified Wednesday in a Moline man's sexual abuse trial sided with the defense contention that the man should be innocent by reason of insanity.

Dr. Eric Ritterhoff, a psychiatrist at Franciscan Medical Center, said he had a "high suspicion" that defendant David E. Lundell. 46, of 2302 31st St., showed manic symptoms during December 1986. when the alleged offenses against

Paul Skinner, a psychologist at Franciscan, said Lundell's criminal actions were "related to his insanity."

Lundell is charged with three counts of aggravated criminal sexual abuse and one count of aggravated criminal sexual assault.

The prosecution says Lundell twice performed anal sex on a 14year-old boy, made the boy perform anal sex on him and performed oral sex on the boy's 10year-old brother.

A psychiatrist and psychologist are expected to testify for the prosecution today that Lundell is not criminally insane.

During Wednesday's session. special prosecutor Greg G. Chickris questioned Skinner's opinion because Skinner's examination occurred after Lundell's arrest. when Lundell could have known he was going to use insanity as a




