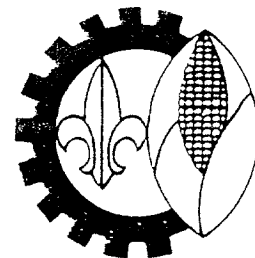



Psychiatrist backs insanity plea in sex abuse trial

Witnesses who testified Wednesday in a Moline man's sexual abuse trial sided with the defense contention that the man should be innocent by reason of insanity.

Dr. Eric Ritterhoff, a psychiatrist at Franciscan Medical Center, said he had a "high suspicion" that defendant David E. Lundell, 46, of 2302 31st St., showed manic symptoms during December 1986, when the alleged offenses against

two young brothers occurred.

Paul Skinner, a psychologist at Franciscan, said Lundell's criminal actions were "related to his insanity."

Lundell is charged with three counts of aggravated criminal sexual abuse and one count of aggravated criminal sexual assault.

The prosecution says Lundell twice performed anal sex on a 14-year-old boy, made the boy perform anal sex on him and performed oral sex on the boy's 10-year-old brother.

A psychiatrist and psychologist are expected to testify for the prosecution today that Lundell is not criminally insane.

During Wednesday's session, special prosecutor Greg G. Chickris questioned Skinner's opinion because Skinner's examination occurred after Lundell's arrest, when Lundell could have known he was going to use insanity as a defense.

Chickris also called witnesses who said Lundell had seemed normal to them.

Testimony opens in sex abuse trial

Testimony begins today in the Rock Island County Circuit Court trial of a Moline Boy Scout leader accused of sexually abusing two brothers.

Jury selection was completed Monday in the trial of David E. Lundell.

Lundell, 46, of 2302 31st St., is charged with three counts of aggravated criminal sexual abuse and one count of aggravated criminal sexual assault against 14- and 10-year-old brothers.

Lundell pleaded innocent by reason of insanity to all of the charges.

The state charges that Lundell twice performed sex acts with the 14-year-old, made the boy do sex acts with him and performed sex acts with the 10-year-old during December 1986.

Special prosecutor Greg G. Chickris said Lundell committed the alleged crimes at the boys' home.

Chickris said Lundell, as a Boy Scout leader, gained the trust of the boys by making model airplanes with them.

Lundell was arrested Feb. 27 and is being held in Rock Island County Jail on \$50,000 bond.

Jury finds sex abuser mentally ill — but guilty

David E. Lundell of Moline was found guilty, but mentally ill, Thursday of sexually abusing two young brothers in December 1986.

An eight-man, four-woman jury took almost six hours to reach its verdict in Rock Island County Circuit Court.

Lundell, 46, of 2302 31st Ave., sat emotionless as the court clerk read the verdict.

Lundell was convicted on three counts of aggravated criminal sexual abuse and one count of aggravated criminal sexual assault. Lundell had been accused of

twice performing anal sex on a 14-year-old boy, making the boy perform anal sex on him and performing oral sex on the boy's 10-year-old brother.

The jury had to address the question of whether Lundell should be acquitted because he was legally insane when the acts occurred.

During closing arguments, special prosecutor Greg G. Chickris argued that the evidence against Lundell proved his sanity.

"I don't think (Lundell) is perfectly normal at all," Chickris said. "But the defendant's state of mind doesn't fall within the legal

definition of insanity."

Lundell's attorney, David C. Hoffman, argued that Lundell suffered from a mental illness that caused the criminal behavior.

"We're talking about a psychotic driven by a manic disorder," he said.

Being found guilty, but mentally ill, means Lundell still faces prison terms for the offenses, but he may receive medical treatment, Chickris said.

The assault charge carries a prison term of between 6 and 30 years. The abuse charges carry prison terms of between three and seven years each, Chickris said.

Records: Suspect has sex abuse past

A Moline man charged with sexually abusing two brothers kept records indicating he also had sexual experiences with six other boys, testimony at the man's trial showed Tuesday.

David E. Lundell, 46, of 2302 31st St., is charged with three counts of aggravated criminal sexual abuse against a 14-year-old

boy and one count of aggravated criminal sexual assault against the boy's 10-year-old brother in December 1986.

Lundell has pleaded innocent by reason of insanity.

During the first day of testimony, Moline Police Department Det. Gregory Heist said Lundell volunteered information detailing sexual experiences with six boys other than the brothers in 1981 and 1986 at Lundell's mobile

home in Milan.

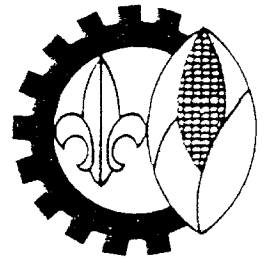
Heist said Lundell would gain the boys' confidence by inviting them over to build model airplanes. He would also show magazines depicting nude women to arouse the boys and teach them about sex, Heist said Lundell told him.

Heist said Lundell, who was arrested Feb. 27, was cooperative and offered the information without an attorney being present.

Lundell also allowed Heist to search his home and helped find material, Heist said.

Among the items taken from Lundell's home were record books detailing his sexual contacts, notes about Illinois state statutes on sexual crimes and a letter from the Council on Children noting his interest in volunteering to work on the children's "Helpline," Heist said.

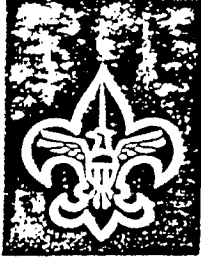
Though he was registered as a Explorer Advisor at the time of his arrest, the youth that he has been charged with sexually abusing, were not members of the Scouting program.

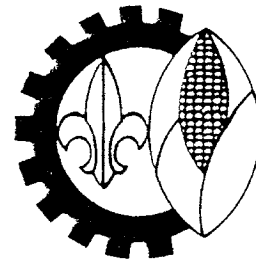



Moline man, 45, charged with abusing two boys sexually

A Moline man faces four felony charges of having sex with two boys ages 10 and 14.

David E. Lundell, 45, of 2302 31st St., Apt. 15, Moline, was charged with one count of aggravated criminal sexual assault, and three counts of aggravated criminal sexual abuse. The first count, alleging sexual penetration with the 10-year-old, is a class X felony, punishable with six to 30 years in

prison. The three other charges are class 2 felonies, punishable by three to seven years in prison.

The mother of the two boys reported the incidents Wednesday. Lundell was charged Friday, said Moline police Detective Greg Heist.

Mr. Lundell has no criminal history and had been unemployed for three years, Heist said.

The boys and Lundell formerly lived near each other in Moline, Det. Heist said.

"They had just known each other from the past, but they do not live near each other," he said.

Mr. Lundell waived a preliminary hearing today and was bound over for trial. He remains in the Rock Island County Jail in lieu of \$50,000 bond.
