

Interview with Scouts: Came in after Scouts entered - followed boys all week - Wednesday and Monday night also followed Scouts around camp during the week. Identification of subject was made by telling what subject was wearing at Friday morning flag ceremony (yellow, "Do It Now, Nike) shirt.

- 10:45 a.m. Scout Executive reported alleged incident to Al Morin, Area (State) Director of the Boy Scouts of America.
- 10:50 a.m. Scout Executive telephoned Department of Social Services and reported alleged incident representative of Department of Social Services stated that an officer would contact the Scout Executive between 1:00 and 3:00 p.m. this day.
- 11:00 a.m. Scout Executive contacted executive board member and retired State Police Captain, John K. Cosgrove, Boy Scout executive board member in charge of such matters and reported incident to him.
- 12:00 noon Scout Executive went to council office and retrieved membership records on both Scout troops involved.
- 12:15 p.m. Scout Executive made a confidential call to former district executive, Brian Granger, a troop committeeman of the alleged offender's troop, for the purpose of checking out the alleged offender's background. Mr. Granger reported that there had been no previous incidents in the accused background.

Scout Executive proceeded to camp.

- 1:15 p.m. Department of Social Service's agent telephone Scout executive at camp. The Department of Social Service's agent stated that, since the Scout executive intended to ask the alleged offender to leave camp, the Department of Social Services would not be involved in any child protection and to report the incident to the law enforcement agency with jurisdiction.
- 1:25 p.m. Scout Executive contacted Michigan State Police, more specifically, Trooper Ray Burke. Trooper Burke directed the Scout executive to keep the alleged victims and the alleged offender in camp until he could come to camp at 4:00 p.m.
- 2:30 p.m. Scout Executive met with two Scouts and requested that they come back at 4:00 p.m. to visit with Trooper Burke.
- 2:45 p.m. Scout Executive met with accused Scoutmaster and asked him to meet with Trooper Burke at 4:30 p.m.
- 3:15 p.m. Scout Executive attempted to telephone both alleged victims' parents. Scout Executive got in telephone contact with one and informed her that the Trooper would be meeting with her boys at 4:00 p.m. She stated that she would contact the other parent and inform her of that fact.
- 4:15 p.m. State Trooper Ray Burke interviewed the alleged victim and the witness.



Interview with leader: As reported to Robert McManus - subject in shower with Scouts - moved in with boys when opportunity presented itself - after "joining Scouts" subject patted on buttocks - witnessed incident. Three other Scouts acknowledged movement of leader to side with boys, but did not witness the "touching".

Interview with Scouts: Came in after Scouts entered - followed boys all week - Wednesday and Monday night also followed Scouts around camp during the week. Deliberate touching - not accident, according to victim and witness. Identification of subject was made by telling what subject was wearing at Friday morning flag ceremony (yellow, "Do It Now, Nike) shirt.

CHRONOLOGY OF FOLLOW UP TO REPORTED INCIDENT

Friday, July 20, 1990

10:00 a.m.

Camp Operations Director contacted Scout Executive, Paul J. Ryan and reported that two Scouts of Troop 27 had a possible molestation performed by a Scoutmaster (of another troop) at 10:30 p.m. the previous evening.

Scout Executive reported alleged incident to Al Morin, Area 10:45 a.m. (State) Director of the Boy Scouts of America. Scout Executive telephoned Department of Social Services and 10:50 a.m. reported alleged incident - representative of Department of Social Services stated that an officer would contact the Scout Executive between 1:00 and 3:00 p.m. this day. Scout Executive contacted executive board member and retired 11:00 a.m. State Police Captain, John K. Cosgrove, Boy Scout executive board member in charge of such matters and reported incident to him. Scout Executive went to council office and retrieved membership 12:00 noon records on both Scout troops involved. Scout Executive made a confidential call to former district 12:15 p.m. executive, Brian Granger, a troop committeeman of the alleged offender's troop, for the purpose of checking out the alleged offender's background. Mr. Granger reported that there had been no previous incidents in the accused background. Scout Executive proceeded to camp. Department of Social Service's agent telephone Scout executive 1:15 p.m. at camp. The Department of Social Service's agent stated that, since the Scout executive intended to ask the alleged offender to leave camp, the Department of Social Services would not be involved in any child protection and to report the incident to the law enforcement agency with jurisdiction. Scout Executive contacted Michigan State Police, more 1:25 p.m. specifically, Trooper Ray Burke. Trooper Burke directed the Scout executive to keep the alleged victims and the alleged offender in camp until he could come to camp at 4:00 p.m. Scout Executive met with two Scouts and requested that they 2:30 p.m. come back at 4:00 p.m. to visit with Trooper Burke. Scout Executive met with accused Scoutmaster and asked him to 2:45 p.m. meet with Trooper Burke at 4:30 p.m. Scout Executive attempted to telephone both alleged victims' 3:15 p.m. parents. Scout Executive got in telephone contact with one and informed her that the Trooper would be meeting with her boys at

4:15 p.m. State Trooper Ray Burke interviewed the alleged victim and the witness.

| July 21 | Scout Executive contacted Area Director and reported results. |
| July 21 | Scout Executive wrote refund check, of registration fee, to offender. |
| July 22 | Scout Executive notified Joseph J. Muha, Council President. |
| July 23 | Scout Executive wrote registered letter revoking registration in the Boy Scouts of America to alleged offender and enclosed a check for \$7 registration refund. |
| July 24 | Scout Executive contacted the National Council, Boy Scouts of America, and reported the incident to the director of registration. |
| July 29 | Attempted to contact Methodist Church, Alanson, and found Pastor not in area for extended period. |
| July 29 | Informed Brian Granger, Troop 4 Committeeman and former District Executive, to advise that accused should not have contact with Scouts. |
| August 2 | Accused contacted Roger Clark, Troop 4 Assistant Scoutmaster and District Committee Member, that he would not be active in troop. |
| August 2 | Mr. Clark contacted Scout Executive, by phone, and asked why accused had removed himself from troop. Scout Executive confidentially informed Mr. Clark that accused could no longer participate and requested Mr. Clark to conduct future troop functions, at least on temporary basis. |
| August 6 | Scout council sent badge order, originally ordered by accused, to Mr. Clark for distribution. |

Ed Brochu, District Chairman and accused's employer, contacted Scout Executive and asked why accused had "resigned". Scout Executive briefed District Chairman. District Chairman stated that he would maintain confidentiality and the accused would not have his employment in jeopardy.

August 7

Scout Executive mailed this accounting, copy of letter to accused, copy of postal restricted delivery acceptance card signed by accused, and National Ineligible Volunteer Record Sheet to: Area Director; National Registration Service; William Wise, Council Vice President/Law.

The results of this incident are in the hands of the Michigan State Police investigation unit.

Please be advised that the alleged victims nor their parents know the name and address of the accused and the accused does not know the names or address of the victims — it would be wise to maintain this confidentiality at present.

We reserve the right to refuse registration whenever there is a concern that an individual may not meet the high standards of membership which the BSA seeks to provide for American youth.

If you wish to have this decision reviewed by a BSA regional review committee, please write to the regional director within 60 days of the date of this letter, explaining your version of the facts supporting your claim that your registration as a BSA member should be reinstated. The procedures for a review of this decision are attached.

- 2. Upon the receipt of your written request, a committee will be appointed to review the situation.
- 3. You may attend the review hearing, but it is not adversarial in nature and neither the committee nor you will be represented by legal counsel. If you wish, you may be accompanied by no more than two individuals if their testimony might assist the committee in discovering the truth and arriving at a correct decision.
- 4. The committee will review the facts as presented, and may interview any persons whose testimony might assist them in arriving at a correct decision.
- 5. You will receive a letter setting forth the decision of the committee.
- 6. If you disagree with the decision of the committee, you may request a review of this decision by the National Council of the Boy Scouts of America.
