**Ex-Scoutmaster Gets  
7 Years in Sex Case**

ALFRED, Maine (AP) — A former scoutmaster who was sentenced to prison for seven years in a sex abuse case involving a Kittery youth plans to appeal his conviction.

David J. Brunette, 41, of Kittery was given a 10-year prison sentence, with three years suspended. He was convicted last month after a four-day Superior Court trial on charges of gross sexual misconduct, unlawful sexual contact and endangering the welfare of a child.

The offenses were alleged to have taken place in Kittery in 1982 while Brunette and the youngsters, who were then 14, were supposed to have been camping.

Justice William S. Brodric, in imposing sentence Monday, said the most aggravating circumstances were that Brunette was a scoutmaster and that he gave the youngsters a ride in his car during the (unclear) incident.

Brunette, an electrician and electronics amateur, also owned a small boat and was in the process of building a boat for the Maine State Council.

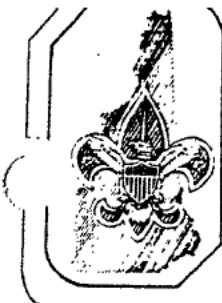

For the record, Mr. Brunette is 5'10", weighs 195 lbs., has brown hair and brown eyes. His Social Security No. is [REDACTED]

Mr. Brunette was charged with four separate misdemeanors in the State of New Hampshire and was found guilty on all counts. He received a fine and a 3 month jail sentence with one month suspended. He is presently appealing the sentence. Also supporting paperwork for this is enclosed.

In addition, Mr. Brunette has also been charged with endangering the welfare of a child in the State of Maine and we understand that the particular case is to be considered by the Grand Jury which is scheduled to meet some time later on...probably late October or so. What little paperwork we have been able to secure on this is also included and has been marked with a piece of red tape.

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**AFFIDAVIT for REQUEST to ISSUE ARREST WARRANT**

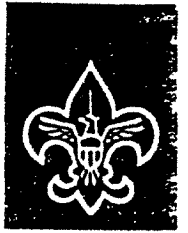
