

On December 7, 1987, your plea of guilty to sexual abuse in the third degree was accepted by the Associate Circuit Court of Buchanan County, Missouri.

As a result of this conviction, the Executive Committee of the Pony Express Council has determined that your registration with the Boy Scouts of America should be suspended, and that you should no longer be permitted to participate in any activities related to the Boy Scouts of America.

If you wish to have this decision reviewed further, please submit to me in writing your reasons for your request for review, together with any supporting documentation you wish to have considered.

JUDGMENT AND SENTENCE

Defendant appears in person, and with <u>Dan Adams</u>, Assistant Public Defender defendant's attorney, and having been arraigned, informs the Court that defendant desires to enter a plea of guilty to the charge of <u>Class A Wisdemeanor of Sexual Abuse in the Third Degree</u>.

The Court personally addresses the defendant in open Court and informs defendant (1) of the nature of the charge; (2) the mandatory minimum and the maximum penalty provided by law; (3) that defendant has right to plead not guilty or to persist in the plea which defendant has heretofore entered; (4) that defendant has the right to be tried by a jury and at the trial has a right to assistance of counsel, the right to confront and cross-examine witnesses against defendant, and the right not to be compelled to incriminate himself.

Defendant is further advised that if defendant pleads quilty, there will not be a further trial of any kind and by pleading quilty defendant waives the right to a trial.

The defendant is sworn and examined. The Court finds that defendant fully understands the charge against defendant, the range of punishment and the consequences of defendant's plea of guilty; that defendant has freely and voluntarily, in open court pleaded guilty and signed a petition to enter a plea of guilty with the full knowledge and understanding of the contents thereof; that the plea of guilty is not the result of force or threats or of promises apart from the plea agreement filed herein; that defendant's willingness to plead guilty does not result from prior discussions between the prosecuting attorney and the defendant or defendant's attorney, except as reflected by the plea agreement filed herein. The Court further finds that there is a factual basis for the plea and that the defendant is in fact guilty of the charge.

Therefore, the Court accepts defendant's plea of guilty as charged and fixes defendant's punishment at <u>a term of six</u>
months in the Buchanan County Jail.
Court suspends execution of sentence and places defendant on
probation for a period of 2 years on condition that defendant
serve 15 days shock detention in the Buchanan County Jail and
other conditions set out in the Court's Order of Probation.

The Court grants judgment against the defendant in the sum of \$36.00 in favor of the State of Missouri, for the Crime Victim Compensation, as required by state statute. Defendant is further ordered to pay the sum of \$75.00 for the Public Defender fees Defendant is given credit for ${-1-}$ days served in jail.
