NATURE OF PROCEEDINGS Report and Sentencing

ACTION NO. 2309

Matter is called.

Defendant is present in court with counsel.

Mr. Martin states plea agreement as follows:

If the defendant pleads guilty to Count I, a violation of Section 288(a) P.C.; Count VIII, a violation of Section 288a(c) P.C.; Count X, a violation of Section 288(a) P.C.; and Count IX, a violation of Section 288a(b)(2) P.C., the People will dismiss the remaining counts, those being Counts II, III, IV, V, VI, VII, XI, XII, and VIII.

The court advises the defendant of his basic constitutional rights.

Defendant states that he understands and waives these rights.

Mr. Test states & clarifys that the defendant would be pleading guilty to Count IX as the principal count for which he would serve two (2) years and the remaining counts would be subordinate counts; the defendant would serve a total of eight (8) years.

The defendant freely and voluntarily waives his right to a Jury Trial.

The People waive their right to a Jury Trial.

Mr. Test concurs with his clients waiver of rights.

The defendant withdrawls his not guilty plea.

The court accepts the defendant's withdrawal of a not guilty plea.

The defendant pleads guilty to Count I, a violation of Section 288(a) P.C.; Count VIII, a violation of Section 288a(c) P.C.; Count IX, a violation of Section 288a(b)(2) P.C.; and Count X, a violation of Section 288(a) P.C.

Mr. Tests states that the court indicated in chambers that the court would stay commencement of sentence for thirty (30) days.

The court concurs.

The court hereby accepts the defendants plea of guilty to Counts I, VIII, IX and X.

Mr. Martin concurs with the defendants plea of guilty to Counts I, VIII, IX, and X.

Mr. Martin feels that it would be in the best interests of justice to accept defendants pleas to said counts and further moves to dismiss Counts II, III, IV, V, VI, VII, XI, XII and XIII.

The court accepts dismissal of Counts II, III, IV, V, VI, VII, XI, XII and VIII.

Counsel waives time for judgment.

The court has read and considered all reports.

The court denies probation and imposes the middle term for Count IX of the information.

The court sentences the defendant in Count IX to two (2) years in state prison.

Count IX is the principal term and Counts I, VIII and X are subordinate terms.

The court imposes 1/3 of the middle term for Counts I, VIII and X, which is two (2) years for each count.

The total time imposed on the defendant is eight (8) years in state prison.

The defendant is remanded to the custody of the Sheriff for transport to Vacaville. The court will defer date that the defendant must report to the Sheriff for thirty (30) days. Defendant is to report to the Sheriff July 19, 1985 @ 5:00 P.M.

Mr. Test requests that the defendant be allowed to leave the state for a trip to Lake Tahoe for three (3) days.

Mr. Martin has no objection.

Court grants this request.
