We immediately asked the SM and Coordinator to meet with Mr. Miller to ask for his resignation during any investigation, which they did.



The incident was a Father/Son Webelos & Scout Campout at Beaumont in March of 1988. They were staying in a cabin. In an attempt to clean one of the boys, Mr. Miller and several scouts undressed and washed this scout. While doing so, Mr. Miller touched the boy's private parts. The boy was obviously embarrassed by the whole affair and went crying to his bunk.

The entire event was thoroughly investigated for several months by the Ashtabula Police at the request of the parents in August 1989.

No Charges were filed.
