We had a recent incident involving one of our Assistant Scoutmasters, Dennis E. Kellar, and one of our Scouts,

family pursued it through the courts and Dennis Kellar was convicted. I have enclosed a copy of the court record. The incident was not as serious as it could have been, but I think does warrant his being placed on our confidential list. Dennis E. Kellar has been serving as Assistant Scoutmaster of Troop 110, sponsored by First Evangelical Lutheran Church, Barberton, Ohio. He is age 31, height 6 ft., weight approximately 210 pounds; hair black; eyes dark; no glasses; wears a mustache, and has a full head of hair. He is single, a high school graduate from Barberton High School. He was employed at Babcock & Wilcox Company as a foreman in the shipping department, and worked as a reserve policeman for the Barberton police force. He has served as president of the Barberton Little League and is active in the Department of Wild Life and is a hunter safety instructor.

As far as we know, he has no church affiliation. His hobbies include motorcycling, guns and hunting.
