

CONFIDENTIAL FILE INFORMATION
DECEMBER 12, 1988

Following up on information received from Hart Bullock, S.E., Salt Lake City, I called (10:30am) and spoke to [REDACTED] [REDACTED], Idaho Falls, Idaho. [REDACTED] [REDACTED]

He said that his [REDACTED] was involved in an incident with Dennis J. Empey in the spring of 1981. His [REDACTED], was involved in an Order of the Arrow activity at an LDS Chapel in Idaho Falls. He became sick. He was taken into a room by Dennis Empey. They were alone. Dennis had [REDACTED] lie down; and, after a period of time, he began to fondle [REDACTED], including his privates. [REDACTED] became extremely uncomfortable with this and left the church and went home. This experience was not shared with his father until last fall when [REDACTED] was preparing for his mission. He shared this story in an effort to clear his conscience of his confusion and guilt feelings. [REDACTED] says that he will press charges if Dennis remains in the program.

Dennis has not been registered since February, 1987, and is not currently active in any Scouting programs. Charges have never been made on an official basis.

I received information from Hart Bullock concerning the above named individual. He indicated that sexual abuse had taken place and that Mr. Eempy had confessed to you that this was true. We must have a Confidential Record Sheet in order to establish a file and be able to identify Mr. Eempy should he attempt registration in some other location. I am enclosing one for your use.

Please send us a paper with his signature, if you have this available, as this aids in the identification process. Also, send us any statements from individuals, or a narrative statement of your communication with Mr. Eempy. We must have this type of material, if we are to have a file which will enable us to refuse registration anywhere in the country.

I recently received word that the above named individual has done some sexual child abuse. This would cause him to be placed on the Confidential File.

I am enclosing a Confidential Record Sheet which I would like to have completed, so we may identify Mr. Zempy. We would also like to have a copy of a paper with his signature, as this aids in the identification process.

Please send us as much detailed information as you can which would substantiate our refusal of registration anywhere in the country. Any newspaper clippings, court records, statements from individuals, or other matters would help us in our files. Since we do not know how long ago this occurred or whether this went to the legal authorities, we do not know what to ask for.

If a letter was sent suspending his registration or if he sent a resignation letter, we would also like copies of this.

Please do not hesitate to contact me, if you have any questions.

Dear Paul,

I am enclosing a confidential record sheet for David W. Martin, who is currently registered as an assistant Scoutmaster in troop 410, sponsored by the Christ United Methodist Church of Salt Lake City, Utah.

This past week Mr. Martin attempted to entice a member of their Scout troop into a hot tub in the nude. The boy refused to yield to Mr. Martin's inticements and told his parents and the Scoutmaster of Mr. Martin's actions. When the Scoutmaster visited with Mr. Martin about the incident he was told that Mr. Martin had a history of child sexual fondling and that when he became depressed or down the desire was intensified and he found his desire increaseingly stronger towards younger and younger boys. He also told the Scoutmaster that he was currently undergoing counseling for the child sexual abuse situation.

The Scoutmaster and the Christ United Methodist Church have released Mr. Martin from any Scouting activities and I am preparing a letter to him suspending him from all Scouting involvment, and refunding the remainder of his registration fee for this charter year.

It is my recomendation that David W. Martin be placed in the confidential file and denied registration in any position with the Boy Scouts of America.

Approximately three months ago I was informed of another child abuse situation that occured several years ago involving a boy at Scout camp and a Dennis Eempy, who currently lives in Provo, Utah.



The father told me that his son, now 19 years of age, had told him that, while attending Junoir Leader Training as a young Scout, Dennis Eempy had fondled him in camp. Dennis has been very active in Scouting in Idaho Falls and in Provo, and was scheduled to serve on the National Camp School, which was held here in Utah this past summer. We removed Dennis from that involmment and I advised Reese Falkner, Scout Executive of Provo, Utah, of the information that I had received, and encouraged him to take care of the matter and remove Dennis from any Scouting involvement. Reese informed me that he had met with Dennis and told him that we are aware of his situation, at which time Dennis confessed to a totally seperate sexual child abuse situation from the one that we were aware of. Reese asked him to disassociate himself from Scouting, which he agreed to.

I am not sure whether or not a confidential record sheet was submitted by Reese Falkner on Dennis Eempy. I have attempted to call Reese, but have not been able to find him in when I have made the calls. I promised the boy's father that we would remove Dennis Eempy from all involvements, now and in the future from Scouting. He has agreed not to file suit against the Boy Scouts of America and Dennis Eempy if this is taken care of. If your confidential files do not show Dennis Eempy listed in them I would be pleased to contact Reese Falkner or you might contact him directly to have this matter taken care of.
