

The facts: SM Delmar Gowing, 47, Troop 60, Wacosta (Mich) United Methodist Church, and his twin brother, Donadd ASM, have pleaded guilty to counts of first degree criminal sexual assault involving one 13-year-old Scout on two instances. Their cousin, Donald Bushard, 20, ASM, and Delmar's , 18, an applicant for Eagle, have pleaded innocent to similar charges. Sentencing on the guilty pleas is set for June 10. Allegedly one or more of the men were sexually involved with some 15 boys in the troop (and possibly some of their girl friends) over a two year period. Numerous photos of nude youngsters have been confiscated by police. None of the incidents apparently occurred during official Scout functions. ACTION OR RECOMMENDATIONS: <u>Council in touch with Park and has own legal counsel.</u> Region knowledgeable. Ernst advised.

Boshea met with the Clinton County Sheriff's Office some two years ago in an investigation at that time when allegation were made. He says police uncovered nothing and no action was taken by the BSA council since the police investigation then proved inconclusive and no charges were filed. He says the entire family are pillars of the community, very active in the church involved, and long time leaders of the troop.

"We hope this can now be put behind us, so the people of Wacousta can pick up the pieces and get on with their lives," Clinton County Prosecuting Attorney Jon Newman said after Monday's sentencings.

Bushard, of 9383 Cutler Road, and Jeffrey Gowing, of 9401 Cutler Road, will be sent to Riverside Correctional Facility in Ionia for

young offenders.

They pleaded guilty last month to third-degree criminal sexual conduct for molesting a 13-yearold troop member in two separate incidents.

Newman said he understood Jeffery Gowing received the lesser sentence because the prospects for his rehabilitation were greater.

The prosecutor said that after

the judge noted the need to protect society against criminal behavior. Tahvonen told the youths their convictions did not "close the door" to changing their behav-. which ior. would be up to. them.

Michigan news in brief 2 more sentenced in Scout abuse case

ST. JOHNS, Mich. — Two men active in Wacousta, Mic Boy Scout Troop 60 were sentenced in Clinton County Circ. Court for sexually assaulting members of the troop.

Jeffrey Gowing, 18, son of former Scout leader Donald Gowin received four to 15 years in prison yesterday. And Dona Bushard, 20, a friend raised by Jeffrey Gowing's uncle, Delma was sentenced to eight to 15 years.

Both had pleaded guilty to reduced charges of third-degr criminal sexual conduct. According to the State Department Corrections, Gowing will be eligible for parole in September 198 Bushard in December 1991.

Two weeks ago in the same courtroom and as part of the san case, the twins Delmar and Donald Gowing, 47, both former Sco leaders, were sentenced to 50-to-75-year terms for first degr criminal sexual assaults against Scouts from Troop 60.

"You befriended and betrayed these youngsters," Circuit Cou Judge Randy L. Tahvonen told Jeffrey Gowing. "Two weeks a. your father wanted the court to forgive him and it couldn't ... suspect he will die in prison. You won't and that's one price the court won't require you to pay."

Gowing responded that he wanted to say he was "sorry to th families of the victims" and "wanted to pay his debt to society ar.

Tahvonen noted that seven of Gowing's teachers and a school counselor wrote letters stressing Jeffrey's conscientious attitud 3.25 high school average and college ambitions. One letter from victim's family expressed hope that Gowing would receive therap and not prison.

"I think there was a difference in the sentencing (betwee Bushard and Gowing) because of the judge's thoughts o

rehabilitation (for Gowing)," said Gowing's attorney. However, Clinton County Prosecutor Jon Newman said tha both men deserved the same sentence and that Gowing has bee denying a problem at home between himself and his father. "I'n convinced that (Gowing) was attacked by his father and uncle. Newman said. "I don't see that Jeff is any more salvageable ... tha. Donald Bushard. The damage has been done."

2 Scout leaders enter guilty pleas

ST. JOHNS (UPI) — Two Boy Scout leaders pleaded guilty to sexual conduct involving a Scout under their direction Monday, while other charges against them were dropped.

Pleas were entered in Clinton County Circuit Court by Delmar Gowing, scoutmaster for six years of Wacousta Troop 60, and his twin brother, Donald, an assistant scoutmaster.

The charges carry possible life terms.

Two others still are awaiting preliminary examination in the case, which has sent shock waves through Wacousta, a rural community northwest of Lansing.

The Gowings — 47-year-old residents of Eagle — pleaded guilty in return for the prosecutor's agreement to drop a charge of first-degree criminal sexual conduct and two charges of second-legree criminal sexual conduct against Donald Gowing.

Prosecutor Jon Newman said he agreed to the arrangement in order to wrap the case up as rapid: ly as possible for the sake of the youngsters involved.

But the prosecutor said there was no agreement on what sen-

tence he will recommend.

In entering their pleas, the Gowings said they too hoped to spare victims any further suffering. Later, they expressed regret over what happened.

The count to which the Gowings pleaded guilty relates to an April 17 incident involving a 13-year-old Scout.

The brothers' bond was revoked, and they were sent to the Clinton County Jail pending sentencing June 10.

The case involves alleged assaults on boys ages 11 to 15 over a period of years.

A number of photographs of the incidents were seized at the home of Donald Gowing.

Delmar Gowing was accused in 1981 of raping a 5-year-old boy, but the charge was dismissed at a preliminary examination. Assistant Prosecutor Mary Pino said she informed Boy Scout officials of the charge.

Still facing charges of criminal sexual conduct are Jeffrey Gowing, 18, son of Donald Gowing, and Donald Bushard, 20, who lived with Delmar Gowing.

The two are free on bond.
