dent was found guilty by a Whit man County Superior Court jur here Thursday of taking inde cent liberties with a 12-year-ol Pullman boy. Donald C. Brock of Pullma COLFAX — A 22-year-ol Washington State University st

was found guilty of one count of taking indecent liberties with a minor. A second count on the same charge was not submitted to the jury, and he was found innocent of a third count on the same charge. Each of the other charges involved other boys in separate incidents.

The conviction involved an incident in October 1983 where Brock was found to have had sexual contact with the boy by touching him, according to April McComb, acting prosecutor for Whitman County.


The case was turned over to the 12-person jury about 11 a.m. Thursday after two days of testi-

mony. The jury deliberated for more than four hours before re turning with the verdicts. years in prison on the felon-charge. He was represented by Michael Pettit of Pullman. Sentencing was set by Judg Philip II. Faris for June 25 Brock faces a maximum of 1



Dear Paul:

Sorry for the long delay in responding to your request for further information on Donald C. Brock.

Facts:

Brock was originally charged with 3 seperate counts of taking indecent liberties with juveniles in the Pullman, Wa. area.

Prior to trial one charge was dropped. Brock was found guilty on one charge and innocent on the other.

A motion for a new trial was filed prior to sentencing. The motion was heard August 23 '84. At that time a continuance for sentencing was granted to September 28 '84. On the 28th a continuance to October 12 '84 was granted.

On October 12, Mr. Brock was sentenced to prison - which was reduced to one year in the county jail and 10 years probation.

At that time Mr. Brock appealed his conviction, the county has appointed an attorney for him and the Court retained jurisdiction. Mr. Brock is now living with his parents out of our Council. He reports 3 days a week to the City Police - must remain in his parents home after dark and has been assigned a probation officer. These conditions will continue until his appeal is hear.



Dear Paul:

Enclosed please find confidential record sheet on Donald C. Brock as you requested.

This has been very difficult to obtain. It has become quite clear that the Washington Court System is interested in protecting the "rights" of people awaiting appeals of convictions.

Mr. Brock's case was given to the Washington State Court of Appeals in Spokane, Wa. in 1985. In February 1986 the Court published its opinion upholding his conviction. Mr. Brock appealed to the State Supreme Court and the Court refused to hear the case.

Mr. Brock is now serving a one year jail sentence in Clark County Washington. His conviction, October 12, 1984 carried a 10 year probation and one year in jail.

His home of record in Camas, Wa. is within the territory of the Columbia Pacific Council out of Portland, Oregon.
