


Don has not been served as of today. We will keep you informed as the case progresses.

Subject: Child Abuse Allegation toward Don Kyle

Approximately 9:45 am, this morning, June 20, 1988, I received a phone call from Detective Mike Schweigher. Detective Schweigher is from the Pacific Division of the L.A.P.D., investigating allegations made by a 9 year old from Westminster Elementary School. He told me that the 9 year old saw a movie on child molestation and after viewing it, stepped forward to tell about Don Kyle's abuse.

The Detective explained that he was or is a Webelos Leader in Ventura City Council, and that we should know of the allegations, so he called me. He said that he took a statement from the boy. I asked what were the procedures? I also told him that we had volunteers working in the Deputy District Attorney's Office, such as David Wells and John Wilson. He said that he recognized both names.

Det. Schweigher told me that he will be going out to Don's house to interview him. If he is not there, he will leave his card, inviting him down to the station to be interviewed. The Detective also told me that the boy will be interviewed by a psychiatrist to see if he is capable of handling a court procedure, plus to see if there is enough evidence to carry out proper charges. If there seems to be enough evidence and justification, then he would go to the D.A.'s office and file charges, pick-up a warrant and inform him that he is being accused and brought in on the accusations.

I thanked the Detective for letting us know about the allegations, and that we would appreciate any further information that comes about. I also asked for his name spelling and phone number, so that we could get back to him.

After the conversation, I went to Clarance Barton's office to inform him of this allegation. He was not there, but in a meeting with Mr. Richey.

I found the Staff Orientation Guide concerning Child Abuse, and started compiling the information requested. I asked Myrt Wood for a copy of Troop 34's Charter. I went to Teri Sweets dept. to find out his employment history. Teri was not in, but his file was there so I got his social security number and date of birth. I went to accounting to find out if he is employed, and they said "yes". I called the operator and she said "Mr.

Clarance Barton was there with Mr. Richey. Gene was on the phone with another matter, and then we talked about the problem at hand. We reviewed the procedures that we as Council must follow. I explained to them that Don Kyle is employed by us, and he is registered in Troop 34, in the Venice Marina area.

I told them of my phone call with Det. Schweigher and what was said. Gene told me that I must document what was said by the Detective and our present conversation. He referenced the book as to writing a letter within 48 hours and delivering it. I told him that there is a possiblilty that Don Kyle might be out of town in Hawaii with his Troop. That was also given to the officer, and I guess he already knew from what he said.

I went back a short time later, found Clarance, told him what occurred, and he said he would contact National, after we found out what the Police Report would be, which would reveal the psychiatrist's report on the stability of the youth. We quickly reviewed some things that must be done and he and I went on our way.


We all agreed that as soon as the information came to us in document form, we would continue gathering information on Don Kyle, and we would not over react by having letters typed up, etc.

I returned to my desk and made a phone call at 11:00 am to David Wells, who was out at the time and one to John Wilson, who is on vacation. I started my documentation when David Wells called me at 11:35 am. I explained to him what happened and that we were stuck until official documentation was on hand. David said he would look into it and get back to me this morning or later.

The above information is being submitted to the best of my knowledge and memory.

Re: Don Kyle - Possible Child Abuse Incident

I was called by Dave Wells, Assistant District Attorney, that Anna Overbach, Scoutmaster's wife (Troop 34), had called him that she had been visited by Detective Mike Schweigher, and asked questions about Don Kyle, and his involvement. She called Dave Wells who shared information of the concerned allegations. She wanted to know if the Scouts had told Don Kyle. She told Dave Wells that she had called this office to talk to Clarance Barton, but he was out. Dave asked me to call Mrs. Overbach

I told Mrs. Overbach what was required of the Boy Scouts of America in California, and our policies, and that we were hand-delivering a letter to him at 3:30 pm on his arrival back from Emerald Bay. He was put on a boat at 2:00 pm by our Camp Staff at Emerald Bay. The copy of the letter is in our file.

I assured her that these were allegations at this time and he would have ample time to clear himself if they were not true. It told her that we are keeping the discussion of this matter to a limited number who were involved with Detective Schweiger, and Dave Wells and myself.

Spoke to Jon MacKenzie of our Staff who arranged to have him shipped back from Emerald Bay, only telling the Camp Ranger that he has been dismissed from the Staff and that Mr. Clarance Barton would meet him on his arrival at the boat dock in Long Beach. It is my understanding that Teri Sweet accompanied him.

At 4:40 pm today, I notified the Western Region, Boy Scouts of America, Mr. Richard Parker, Assistant Regional Director of the allegations, and that we were delivering the letter at 3:30 pm.

I brought him up to date on the steps taken.

On Wednesday, June 22, 1988, I was informed by Clarance Barton, that it was necessary for me to act as a witness in serving a letter from the Council, suspending Don Kyle's registration with the Boy Scouts of America.

Clarance and I met Kyle, at the Long Beach Pier, and informed him of steps to be made regarding National Guidelines.

Clarance had left to pull his car up to the loading zone, at which time Don and I were left standing. Don asked, "what's this all about?". I said, "Child molestation allegations were made against you by a student from Westminister Elementary School". He said, "Who ?" - I said, "I don't know".

When Clarance arrived at the loading zone and Don got in the car, Clarance presented him with above mentioned letter. Don read it, signed it, and returned it to Clarance. Clarance stated that there are certain guidelines and regulations that must be followed. Once this situation is resolved, and if it is proven that these allegations are untrue, Scouting activities will resume.

Afterwards, we drove Don to his home in Venice, California. When he got out of the car, he asked, "Who do I contact, and what do I do?". Clarance suggested to him to contact Dave Wells.
