Thanks for your help in completing this matter.

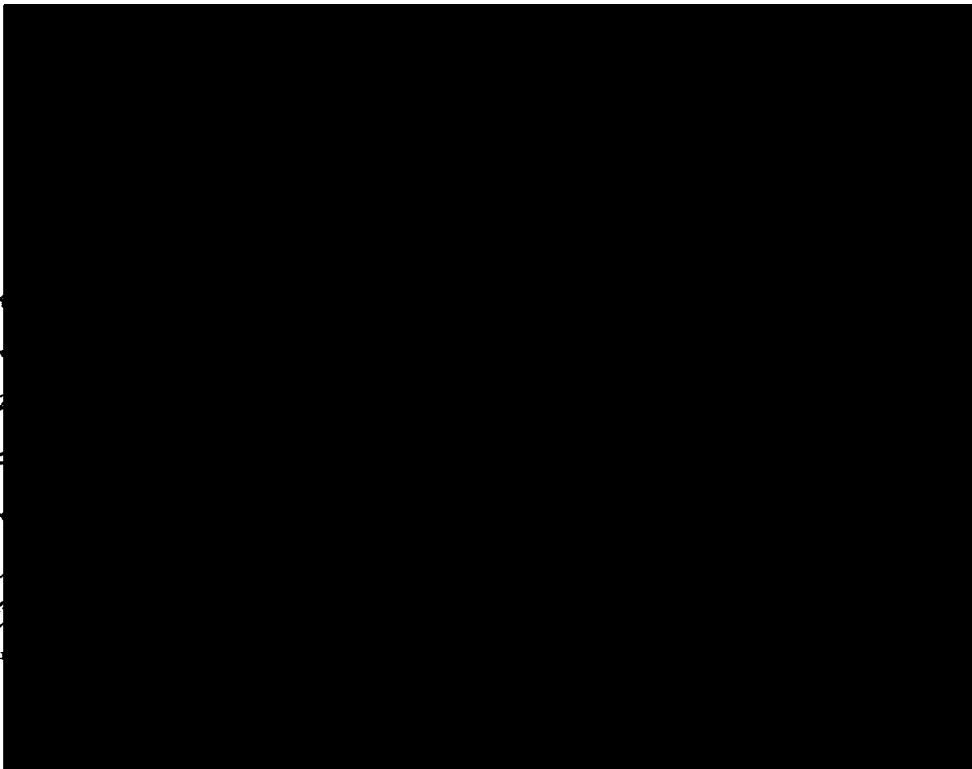

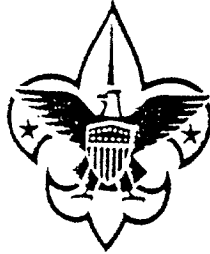

Dear Mr. Matheny:

After careful review, we have decided that your registration with the Boy Scouts of America should be suspended. We are therefore compelled to request that you sever any relations that you may have with the Boy Scouts of America. A refund of your registration fee is enclosed.

You should understand that BSA membership registration is a privilege and is not automatically granted to everyone who applies. We reserve the right to suspend registration whenever there is a concern that an individual may not meet the high standards of membership which the BSA seeks to provide for American youth.

If you wish to have this decision reviewed by a Council Review Committee, please write to me within sixty (60) days of the date of this letter, explaining your version of the facts supporting your claim that your registration as a BSA member should be reinstated. The procedures for a review of this decision are attached.

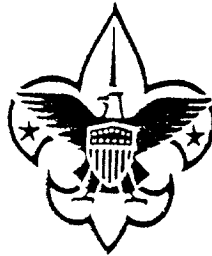

APPLICANT PROCEDURE FOR REQUESTING REVIEW
OF DECISION DENYING REGISTRATION

1. If registration is refused, the applicant may request a review of this decision. This request must be in the form of a written request from the individual which includes his or her version of the facts supporting the claim that registration should not have been denied.
2. Upon receipt of the written request for review, the President of the local Council shall appoint a Committee to review the situation.
3. The appointed Committee should review the facts as presented, and, in addition, may interview any persons whose testimony might assist the Committee in discovering the truth and arriving at a correct decision.
4. A confidential report will be given to the applicant setting forth the decision of the Committee.
5. The applicant may - if he or she does not agree with the decision - request a review from the regional director.
6. If the regional review does not satisfy the applicant, he or she may ask for further review by the National Council. The decision by the National Council is final.

Dear Ted:

Just want to bring you up-to-date on status of our child abuse incident.

1. The "report" we gave to the Western Springs Police Department on Tuesday, May 23, 1989. We also called the Illinois Child Abuse Hotline.
2. Copy of letter we hand delivered to Don Matheny on Tuesday, March 23rd. Present at this face to face meeting were Ross Johnson, Council President; Bill Ramey, Council Commissioner; Ed Black, Program Director; and Don Matheny.
3. Informed our Executive Board of the accusation and action to date, on Tuesday, May 30th.
4. Issued this statement to our Council employees, Friday 2nd, indicating any inquiries are to be directed to me.

The investigation is underway. People are beginning to become aware of the allegations. Requested our staff review their material on how to deal with a child abuse accusation.

The investigation team is apparently composed of representatives from the Illinois Department of Children and Family Services, Illinois State Police, States' Attorney Office, and the Western Springs Police Department. We are maintaining a file of details as they occur.

So far this matter has maintained a very low profile. Hope it stays that way.
