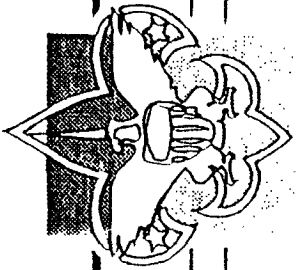

Boy Scout leader gets 30 years for abusing 6 youths

A Kansas City assistant Boy Scout leader was sentenced to 30 years in prison Friday for sexually assaulting six boys.

Earl Flear, 51, pleaded guilty in April to sodomizing and abusing boys he met through scout troop activities. The children ranged in age from 11 to 15 years old.

The boys continue to suffer emotionally, their parents told Circuit Judge H. Michael Coburn during the sentencing hearing Friday.

"I don't know what to answer when my child asks, 'Mom, is he gonna come after all of us?'" one child's mother said. "I don't know what to say when he says, 'Mom, what did I do wrong?'"

"There is nothing I can do to convince him it is not his fault," she said.

Another parent said her boy had become violent at times, fearful and withdrawn at other times.

"He doesn't want to be around any man," she said.

Assistant Prosecutor Chip McKenzie told Coburn that the mother of one boy had her son tested for AIDS, then was afraid to go pick up the test results.

Flear's lawyer, Steven Bogler, said his client wanted to be sentenced to probation so that he could work and help pay for psychological counseling for his victims.

"My client was a victim of sexual abuse as a child," Bogler said. "He is willing to pay for counseling for the children so they don't grow up to do what he did."

McKenzie said Flear's financial assistance wasn't necessary. The boys were in counseling, and state funds were helping foot the bill.

What the victims needed was assurance that Flear wouldn't be around to assault another child, McKenzie said.

Please be advised that my clients have retained me on a 40% contingency fee with respect to their claims.

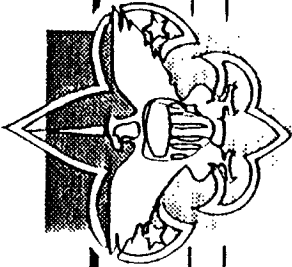

Scout leader admits guilt in sexual assault cases

A Kansas City assistant Boy Scout leader admitted Friday in Jackson County Circuit Court that he sexually assaulted six boys. Earl Flear, 51, was convicted of deviate sexual assault and four counts of sodomy. He confessed to the crimes in a soft, barely audible voice.

In exchange for his guilty plea, prosecutors dismissed seven of 13 felony charges.

Circuit Judge H. Michael Coburn will sentence Flear after an investigation of the man's background. Flear faces a maximum sentence of 82 years in prison.

The boys ranged in age from about 11 to 15 years old when they were molested. The crimes occurred at Flear's apartment, 1044 W. 41st Place.

Coburn allowed Flear to remain free on bond until sentencing.

Flear worked as an audiovisual technician for the Shawnee-Mission School District until his arrest. He was employed with the school district from March 1985 until August 1990, according to district records.

Boy Scouts and their leaders are taught that no leader is to work alone with a Scout, and Flear did not attack the boys during official Scout activities, said Jane Ann Gorsky Goodwin, director of marketing for the Heart of America Boy Scout Council.

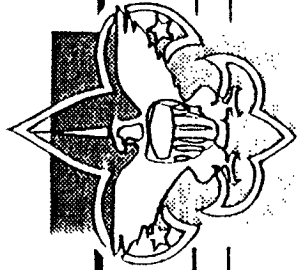

Grand jury issues indictments after sex with boys is reported

Scout leader was fired when parent took report to officials.

A Jackson County grand jury has indicted a Kansas City man on 13 sex-related charges including sodomy and deviate sexual abuse involving six boys during the last two years.

Prosecutors previously had charged 50-year-old Earl A. Fleer with four counts involving two of the boys. He had posted bond in that case in early August, and police arrested him on the new charges at his Midtown apartment Monday evening.

Fleer was an assistant scoutmaster in a local Boy Scouts troop when the crimes occurred. Police learned of the incidents after a parent notified the leader of the

scout troop June 29.

Scouting officials immediately fired Fleer, who was a volunteer, and notified authorities, said Jere Ratcliffe, scout executive of the Heart of America Council.

No crimes occurred during scouting activities, Ratcliffe said. Fleer was notified of scouting regulations that prohibit adults from being alone with children, he said.

Fleer had been an assistant scoutmaster since October 1987.

Fleer was indicted Friday on seven counts of sodomy, three counts of first-degree deviate sexual abuse, two counts of attempted sodomy and one count of first-degree sexual abuse. He was being held at police headquarters Tuesday evening. Bond has been set at \$300,000.

The indictments state that Fleer sodomized five of the boys, committed deviate sexual assault against two of the boys, committed attempted sodomy against two

of the boys and committed sexual abuse against one of the boys.

Sodomy is a class B felony, attempted sodomy and first-degree deviate sexual assault are class C felonies and first-degree sexual abuse is a class D felony.

The boys were all 15 years old or younger when the crimes were committed, the indictments state. One boy was younger than 12.

Fleer had been charged Aug. 1 with two counts of sodomy and two counts of deviate sexual abuse against two boys.

One of the boys told police that Fleer molested him in the Midtown apartment this spring. The boy said a second man, who was not identified in court documents, later sodomized him in the apartment.

The other boy told police that Fleer molested him in a shower in the apartment in the spring of 1989. Both boys told police that Fleer watched pornographic movies with them.

Hayden names district judge

Murguia is Kansas' first Hispanic on bench.

Carlos Murguia, a 32-year-old hearing officer for the Wyandotte County District Court, was appointed district judge Tuesday by Gov. Mike Hayden.

Murguia, who fills a vacancy created by the death of Judge Wayne H. Phillips, is thought to be the first Hispanic lawyer named to a district judgeship in Kansas.

"Personally, I think it's a great honor for me to serve as a District

judge. Judges should make their decisions without regard to their ethnic background, Murguia said, but having a Hispanic judge is a step forward in that it demonstrates to another segment of the community that its members can achieve such a position.

Celso Ramirez, director of the Kansas Advisory Committee on Hispanic Affairs, extensively researched the role of Hispanics in Kansas for publication of a book earlier this summer that profiled 17 prominent Hispanic Kansans.

"To my knowledge, there has never been a Hispanic judge appointed to that level," Ramirez said.

Murguia, an Argentine resident who graduated from the University of Kansas Law School in 1982, has served as the court hearing officer since April, working mainly with child support cases.

Prior to that, Murguia had served for five years as a judge pro tem, or a substitute judge. Hayden made his selection from a panel of three lawyers, a Democrat, nominated by a local selection panel. The others were Wayne Lampton, an assistant city attorney in Kansas City, Kan. and John J. McNally, a lawyer and former county prosecutor.

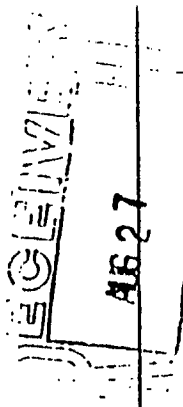

On the following Saturday night, a friend of EARL's who is a white male known only by the first name of "BERT", came into EARL FLEER's bedroom where [REDACTED] was sleeping and pinned his arms to the bed and had anal intercourse with him. BERT also placed his mouth on [REDACTED] penis. [REDACTED] also stated on previous occasions, he has watched adult movies which consist of naked men and women engaged in sexual intercourse with EARL FLEER at his apartment. He stated that no sexual activity occurred between them on those occasions, however, EARL FLEER would sometimes undress and watch the movies while naked.

[REDACTED] gave a formal statement in which he stated that in April or May of 1989, he was at EARL FLEER's apartment located at [REDACTED] when EARL asked him to take a shower with him. EARL FLEER and [REDACTED] took a shower and during the shower, EARL FLEER rubbed [REDACTED] penis with his hand and had [REDACTED] rub his (FLEER's) penis until it became erect. [REDACTED] stated he has also watched adult movies with EARL FLEER.

EARL FLEER has not been questioned regarding this offense.

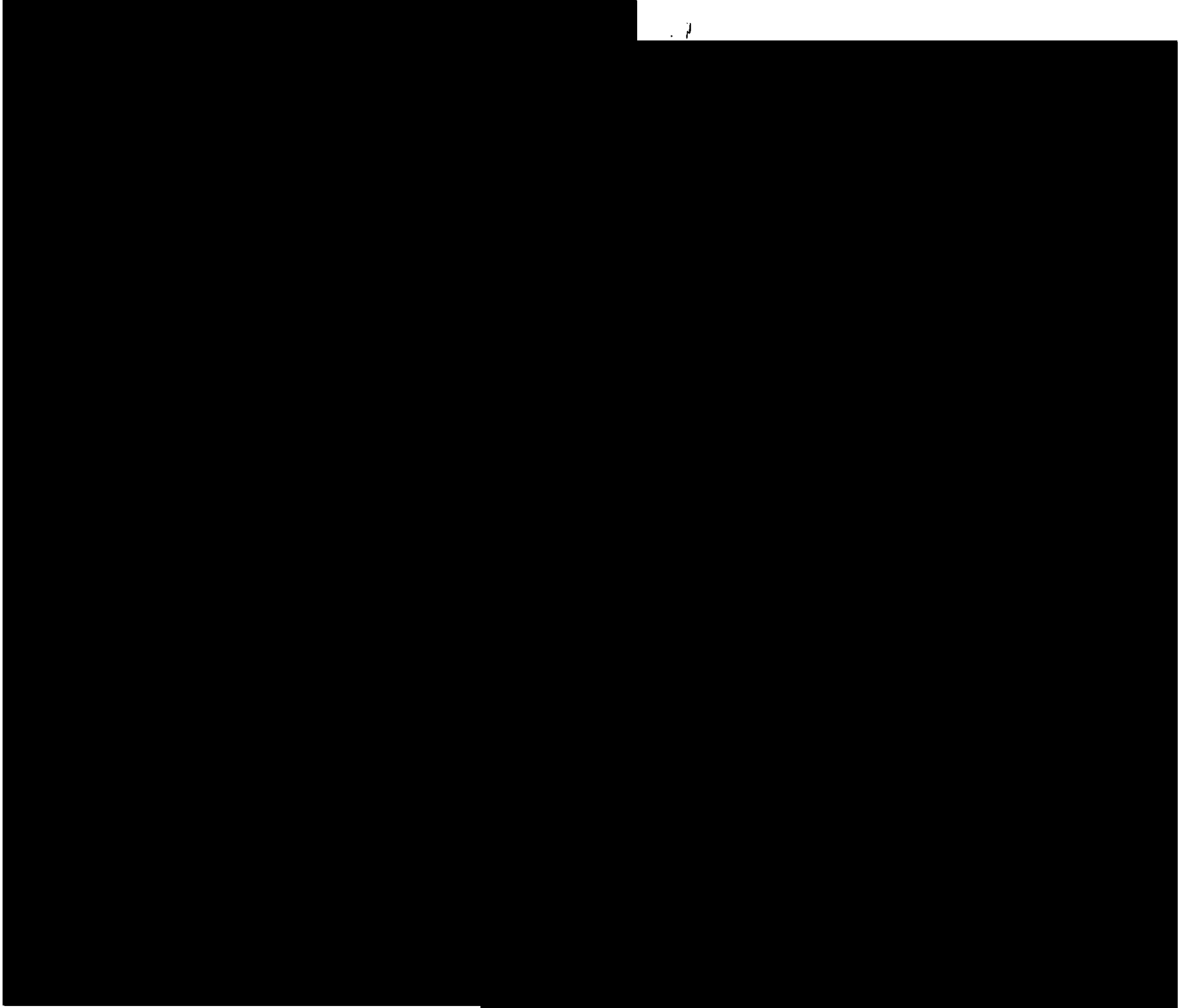

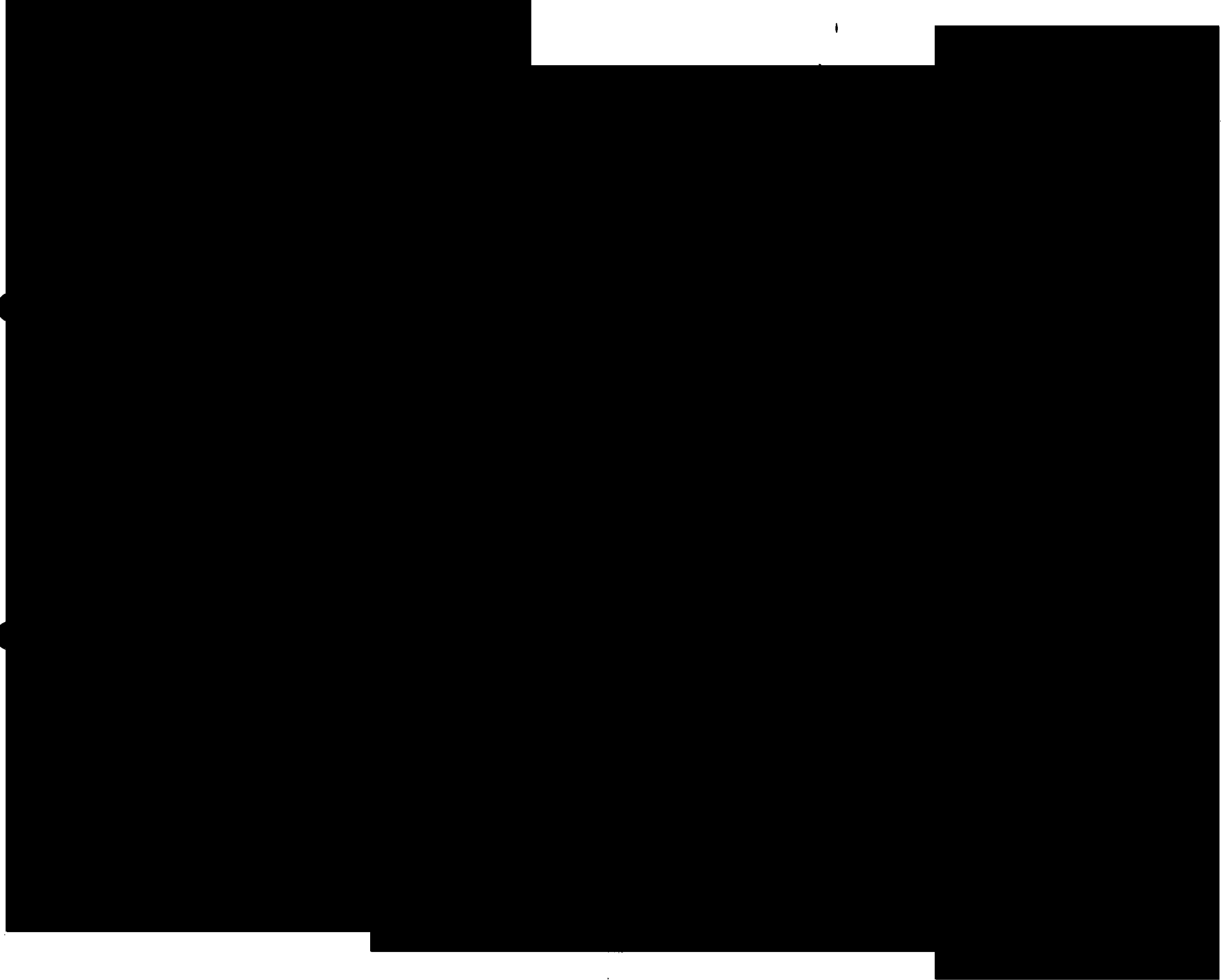

This memorandum will provide a brief summary of information received to date concerning the recent indictment handed down against Earl Fleer.

A thirteen count indictment containing various charges of sodomy, attempted sodomy, and deviant sexual assault was handed down by the Grand Jury against Earl Fleer on Friday, August 24, 1990. Mr. Fleer was arrested on Monday, August 27, 1990. His bond is currently set at \$300,000 secured. He is in custody as of this date awaiting arraignment. Arraignment has been set for September 6, 1990.

The Jackson County Prosecutor's Office is of the opinion that Mr. Fleer has sexually abused two separate groups of boys, all of whom were boy scouts. No charges have yet been filed with respect to Group no. 1. However, my information indicates that another Grand Jury indictment may be in the works with respect to this other group of boys. These boys are apparently the ones who were also victimized by another individual at Mr. Fleer's residence.

Group no. 2 represents the alleged victims of the various sex crimes charged in the indictment which has been handed down. I will obtain a copy of the indictment as soon as Mr. Fleer has been arraigned in Circuit Court.

I will continue to monitor the situation in order to keep abreast of developments which may impact upon the public image of the Boy Scouts.

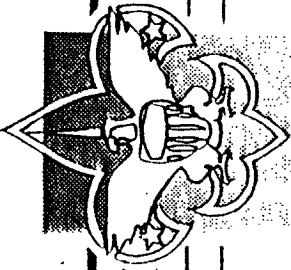

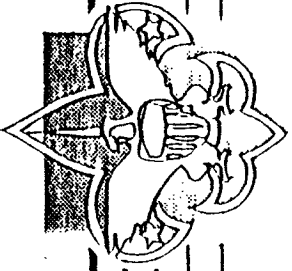

This report is in response to a phone call received by Kevin Henderson.

Early to mid-May Troop 52's Assistant Scoutmaster, Earl Fleeer, had a personal
friend as a guest at his house. Mr. Fleeer also had a Scout from Troop 52 visiting his
home on that same day. Mr. Roland made the accusation that Mr. Fleeer's friend took
advantage of the Scout while Mr. Fleeer was at work. Mr. Roland stated that his
accusation to me is supported by Mr. Fleeer's admittance directly to him that his
friend took sexual advantage of Scout [REDACTED] of Troop 52, Pioneer Trails
District.

Mr. Roland cannot say that Mr. Fleeer was directly involved with the incident but
states that the mother of the Scout thinks he was involved indirectly, Mr. Fleeer
offered to resign from the troop so that no embarrassment will come to the Salvation
Army chartered organization or Boy Scouts.

The mother requested that Mr. Roland not report this incident but he stated to her
that he was obligated to report this incident to the council as stated in Boy Scout
policy.

The Scout will be checked out by his family physician.

Mr. Roland said that the Scout [REDACTED] is often invited by the Assistant
Scoutmaster to the Assistant Scoutmaster's home and that he advised that this is
not a good personal policy to have with members of the troop and cease this type of
activity.

Mr. Fleeer is unmarried.
