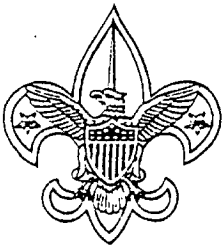

This has been a most difficult case to get to the bottom on. Seems that everyone in the above family is accusing the other one of dastardly deeds.

The wife has been up for "hot checks" in other places, and she was also charged in another city for allegedly contributing to the delinquency of a minor.

The city of Killeen could find no grounds for the charges on Rios and turned the case over to C.I.D. (Criminal Investigation Division) at Fort Hood. The case is now closed, with the findings as follows: Went to court martial late last year, but was acquitted.

I am still sending the Ineligible Volunteer Record Sheet for your files. "Where there's smoke - there could be fire" later on.

Sorry this took so long, but we changed DEs in that area along with our contact at C.I.D., etc. shipping out for "Desert Storm".


Dear Mr. Rios:

After careful review, we have decided that your registration with the Boy Scouts of America should be suspended. We are therefore compelled to request that you sever any relations that you may have with the Boy Scouts of America. A refund of your registration fee is enclosed.

You should understand that BSA membership is a privilege and is not automatically granted to everyone who applies. We reserve the right to refuse registration whenever there is a concern that an individual may not meet the high standards of membership which the BSA seeks to provide for American youth.

If you wish to have this decision reviewed by a BSA regional review committee, please write to the regional director within 60 days of the date of this letter, explaining your version of the facts supporting your claim that your registration as a BSA member should be reinstated. The procedures for a review of this decision are attached.

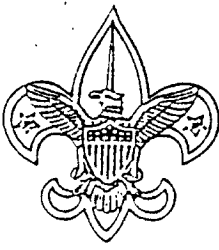

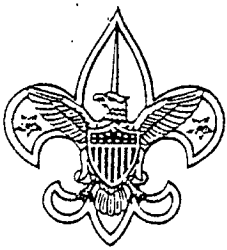

Dear Paul: Re: Edward T. Rios

As we discussed on April 1, 1990, the above named individual, a committee member with Cub Scout Pack 206, Killeen, Texas, was charged with sexually molesting [REDACTED] over a period of years. This was reported to us by Grover C. Peters, Director of Youth Services at Fort Hood.

This has been confirmed with the Family Advocacy Council at Fort Hood, and Mr. Rios is also now listed with the central authority at Fort Sam Houston in San Antonio.

On May 2 the letter suspending Mr. Rios' registration with the Boy Scouts of America was delivered in person to him at his home address - [REDACTED] Killeen, Texas.

The BSA position concerning the suspension was presented. Mr. Rios indicated that he understood and agreed with our action, but indicated that the allegations made by the military were not true and stated that he had engaged a lawyer to meet with Fort Hood officials and clear him. He said the allegations made were affecting his career, homelife, and community activities. Of course, his military unit was already aware of the allegations, but we formally informed them (H.A.C. 553 S & S) at Fort Hood.

Attached is a copy of Mr. Rios' original application for your files. Also, I'll be sending the confidential record sheet as soon as I get all the information. I will keep you apprised of the situation as far as court proceedings and deposition of the case.
